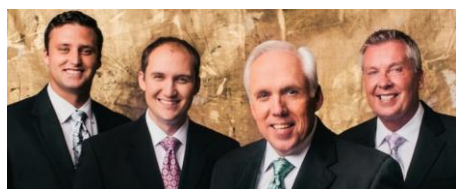

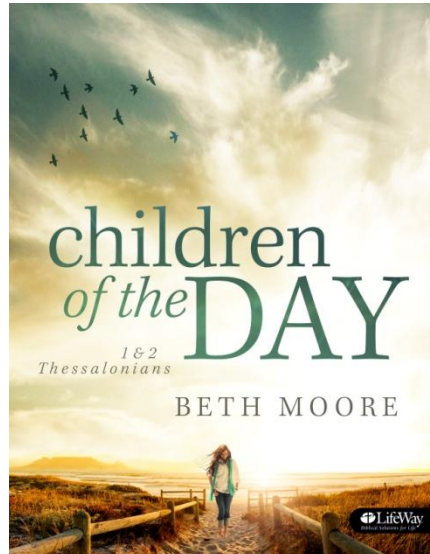
Also mark on your calendar our Gospel Sing May 3rd at 6pm. I love you and I love being your Pastor!

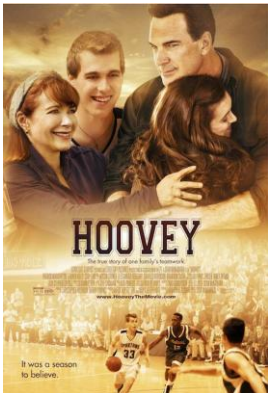
