**GREEN VALLEY BAPTIST ASSOCIATION MOVED FROM
2470 SOUTH GREEN STREET TO 2360 GREEN RIVER ROAD
JUNE 6, 2022**

This has been a historical year for Green Valley Baptist Association. In January, Dr. Phillip Basinger, interim Associational Missions Strategist, approached Calvary Missionary Baptist Church about allowing GVBA to acquire the building & property of the church. The church was struggling due to many members leaving after their pastor left. Per the church constitution, if the church ever ceased to operate the building & grounds would go to the Association. The church voted to turn over the property to GVBA in February.

At a Special Called Business Meeting held on Thursday, March 31, the churches of Green Valley Baptist Association voted to accept the agreement between GVBA & Calvary. The meeting was held at the church building so people could tour the facility & see where the different ministries would be housed. The members of Calvary worked very hard to clean out rooms, replace lights, and made minor repairs to get things ready for GVBA & her ministries. Ms. Rachel Totton-Pugh, daughter of the GVBA Ministry Assistant, Karen Totton, painted the offices & work room & assisted in making minor repairs to walls.

During our May Executive Board meeting we held a dedication service for our new facility. The GVBA moved into the new facility on June 6, 2022. We welcomed World Changers the week of June 13. They painted, cleaned & assisted in moving items from the old building to the new.

This has been a dream for the past 20+ years for Green Valley Baptist Association to have a building where all her ministries could operate under one roof. We express our heartfelt thanks to all who worked so hard to make this dream come true. We praise God for His guidance & to the members of Calvary Missionary Baptist Church for seeing the potential for ministry to glorify Him.

MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING
by and between
CALVARY MISSIONARY BAPTIST CHURCH
and
GREEN VALLEY BAPTIST ASSOCIATION

THE Memorandum of Understanding, hereinafter referred to as “Memorandum”, is made and entered into this the 4th day of May 2022, by and between Calvary Missionary Baptist Church, hereinafter referred to as “Calvary” and the Green Valley Baptist Association, hereinafter referred to as “GVBA”.

WITNESSETH:

WHEREAS, Calvary is a Kentucky non-profit corporation located in Henderson KY; and

WHEREAS, GVBA is a Kentucky non-profit corporation located in Henderson, KY; and

WHEREAS, Calvary and GVBA have reached an agreement concerning the transfer by Calvary of its real property to GVBA and would like to memorialize said understanding.

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the mutual terms and conditions as set forth below, the parties do hereby agree as follows:

1. Calvary and GVBA will properly authorize and execute the deed necessary to transfer the real property located at 2360 Green River Road (hereinafter “Premises”) from Calvary to GVBA.
2. Calvary will continue to operate and conduct its church upon the Premises as herein provided. Calvary will be responsible for paying its own staff ad for all other items related to its ministry.
3. GVBA will be responsible for maintenance and upkeep of the Premises.
4. The sanctuary and fellowship hall portions of the Premises shall not be altered and will be shared and used by both Calvary and GVBA in furtherance of their respective ministries.
5. In addition, Calvary will have the use of the two (2) Sunday school classrooms located across from the Pastor’s office.
6. The Kathy J. Strange ANSWER Center and its operations, being part of the ministry of the GVBA, will be relocated from its current facilities to the Premises. The ANSWER Center will thereupon and thereafter occupy and use the education space of the church building located on the Premises for its operations.
7. When not deployed in ministry, the Disaster Relief mobile vehicles and trailers of the GVBA will be parked and stored on the Premises behind the church building.
8. Except as specifically set forth herein, in all other respects as concerns the Premises, the GVBA as owner shall exercise ultimate authority and control over the Premises and all decisions directly or indirectly impacting the Premises as would be accorded any other owner of real property within the Commonwealth of Kentucky.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF the parties have executed this Memorandum as of the date first above written.

CONSTITUTION

Article I -- Name

This body shall be called the Green Valley Baptist Association.

Article II -- Membership

This Association shall be composed of the cooperating churches sending annual letters to the association, and such other churches as shall be admitted to membership by two-thirds vote of the messengers present at any annual session.

All churches making application for membership in our association shall petition by the guidelines of the association at least two months before any annual session and shall be examined by the Advisory entity of the Administrative Team. This Advisory entity shall report to receive or not to receive the applicant at the next annual meeting.

Article III -- Representation

The representation session of this body shall be held annually and shall be composed of messengers duly chosen by the churches of the association. These representatives constitute themselves into a body. Each church of fifty members or less shall be entitled to three messengers, and one messenger for each additional fifty members, provided that no church shall have more than twenty messengers. All messengers shall be identified to the presiding officer.

Article IV -- Purpose

To serve and equip the cooperating churches in carrying out the Great Commission: This will be done through a cooperative spirit with one another and our brethren of the Kentucky Baptist Convention and the Southern Baptist Convention. It shall also seek to stimulate and sustain Christian fellowship.

Article V -- Officers

The executive officers of this association shall be moderator, vice moderator, clerk, and treasurer. The moderator shall not serve more than two years in succession.

Article VI -- Team Leadership

Under the leadership of the Executive Director, the *On Mission Team* will coordinate the work of the Association through Team Ministry. Each Team Coordinator will make up the On Mission Team, plus a Coordinator. The Teams are: Missions and Ministry Team, Church Functions Team, Administrative Team, Stewardship Team, and Prayer Team. The Coordinators of each Team will lead the work of that particular Team. *The Missions and Ministry Team* will have the following entities: WMU, Baptist Men on Mission, Partnership Missions, disaster Relief, and The ANSWER Center. *The Church Functions Team* will have the following entities: Sunday school and Evangelism, Discipleship and Seminary Extension, Worship and Fellowship. *The Administrative Team* will have the following entities: Advisory, Building & Grounds, and Nominating. *The Stewardship Team* will have the following entities: Finance, Foundation and Stewardship Leadership. *The Prayer Team* will be a three-member Team. All Team Coordinators and members of all entities will be on a three-year rotation.

Article VII -- Executive Board

The Associational Executive Board shall consist of the pastor from each associational church, Team coordinators of the Association, and one lay person from each cooperating church. The Executive Officers of the Association shall be non-voting members of the Board.

The Board shall have the power to make its own internal regulations and do the work of the Association between sessions. This authority shall not include the purchasing or disposal of real estate, nor shall it include the reversal, rescinding, or otherwise changing the action of the Association in regular or called session.

When a vacancy occurs with the Executive Director, the Board shall appoint a Search Committee. The Committee will bring their choice of an interim Director to the Board, as they search for an Executive Director. A two-thirds majority of those voting shall be required to elect an Executive Director

Article VIII -- Annual Meeting

The Associational Year shall be from January 1 – December 31. The Annual Meeting shall be the fourth Thursday in the month of August. The meeting will begin at 4:00 PM for election of Associational Leadership and reporting from the various entities of the Association. A fellowship meal, furnished by the host church, will follow. A worship service will follow the fellowship meal.

The Advisory entity of the Administrative Team shall make all arrangements for the annual meeting.

The churches connected with this body shall furnish information for each annual meeting as called for in the Annual Church Profile. This shall be filed with the clerk at least thirty days before the August annual meeting.

Each messenger must register in order to be allowed to vote.

Article IX -- Authority

This body shall not exercise any authority over a local church. It shall, nevertheless, be the duty of the Association to offer counsel to any church in need of assistance. The doctrinal statement of Green Valley Baptist Association is the 2000 edition of the Baptist Faith and Message.

Article X -- Election Procedures

The officers of this Association shall be nominated during the election session of the yearly annual meeting by a Nominating entity (except for the three members of the Nominating entity) and shall serve during the ensuing year and the following session. The Moderator shall not be eligible to serve longer than two consecutive years.

The Nominating entity shall consist of three members appointed by the Moderator, one each year, during the annual session, for a three-year term. The five team coordinators must be consulted by the Nominating entity.

The Moderator, in consultation with the Team Coordinators, shall designate the chairman of each entity after their election or appointment.

The Moderator and the Executive Director shall be non-voting members of all teams and their entities.

The Nominating entity will also recommend persons to the Executive Board to fill vacancies that occur during the year.

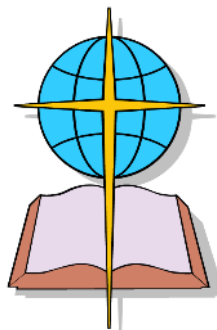
Article XI -- Discipline

Any church failing to send a report (ACP) to the August Annual Session for two successive years shall be dropped from membership in the Association.

It shall be the right of the Association to exclude from its membership any church which may be deemed unorthodox in principle or disorderly in practice, or both. This would be done by two-thirds vote of the messengers present at any Annual Meeting. Before such action is taken, all churches must be notified one month in advance as to when it will be on the agenda. It is understood that this action will not be taken until every reasonable means of reconciliation has been exhausted.

Article XII -- Amendments

This constitution may be amended at the Annual Session by two-thirds of messengers present and voting in favor of the amendment, providing the said proposed amendment shall have been presented to the Advisory entity thirty days prior to the Annual Session and to the Executive Board prior to the Annual Session. Neither approval of the Executive Board nor the Advisory Entity will be required for amendments to go to the Association for consideration. The proposal may be presented at the Annual Session and shall be voted upon at the next Annual Session.



BY-LAWS

Rule of Decorum

In the absence of the Moderator and Assistant Moderator, the Team Coordinator of the On Mission Team will call the meeting to order.

All meetings of this body shall open with devotion and prayer and close with prayer.

No subject shall be discussed without first being offered to the body on motion, and seconded, then fully stated by the Moderator.

Those present after a session is duly called to order shall be considered a quorum to do business.

All motions and questions shall be decided by a majority of votes, except for calling an Executive Director, reception of new churches and amendments to the Constitution which shall require two-thirds majority of the votes.

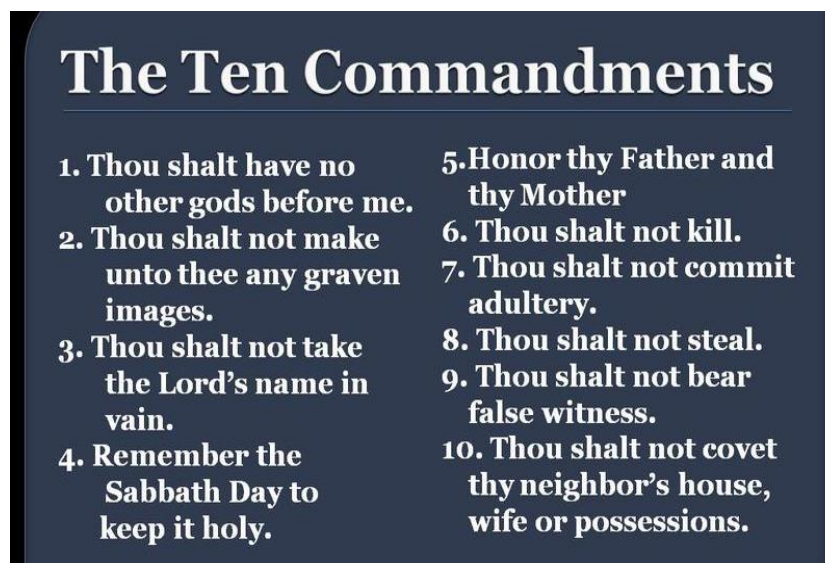
Members wishing to speak shall rise to their feet and address the Moderator, and after being recognized shall proceed. If two or more rise at the same time, the Moderator will decide who may proceed.

In speaking, no member shall digress from the subject under discussion, nor shall the speaker use language calculated to wound the feeling of any other member.

When a proposition is pending and there are amendments proposed, a vote shall be taken on the amendments in order, beginning with the last. A substitute motion shall be voted on before the original motion

No person shall speak more than once on the subject until all who wish to speak have spoken; nor shall any member speak more than twice on the same subject without permission of the moderator, and the second speech may be restricted as to length.

The Association shall be further guided in its parliamentary procedure by **Robert's Rules of Order**.

- Bro. Gary Shoulders, Building & Grounds/Trustees, parsonage needs a new roof. We are asking for approval to use \$8,000 - \$9,000 to repair/replace the roof on the parsonage from the Building Fund. We are making a motion that we receive the funds to repair/replace the roof on the rental property.

Motion approved.

Reports

- Rev. Cohen Copley, GVBA AMS, expressed appreciation to the gathering. We hit the ground running with VBS at several of our churches. It was great to see the effort that churches, large & small, put into VBS. It was also great to see the cooperation between our churches working together. It was wonderful to see the churches working together during **World Changers**. Mt. Pleasant did a great job of hosting this group. We had 26 students at the first meeting of C.R.O.S.S. at HCC. We have had a wonderful time during the Racetrack ministry at Ellis Park. We have seen a great group attending the worship services & meals. The largest group we've seen was 71 attending. We have been visiting all our churches in the association. I would very much like to get together with our pastors in a fellowship time. He spoke on the Equip event on September 12 & in November the KBC Annual Session. If you'd like to ride with him, he would be happy to have you. We are better together. He expressed appreciation for the support of our churches & asked that each give 3% to 5% of undesignated funds to support the mission work of GVBA.
- Bro. Gary Shoulder, Building/Grounds/Trustees Chairman, presented his report on the progress of the building repairs & improvements. We still have a lot to do in the next few months.
- Bro. Ricky Crowder, Finance Team Chairman, presented the state of the finances for GVBA. He walked us through the Custom Summary Report & how we had to revise the budget for 2023 back in March which started in June. \$129,400 was our new budget. We have been receiving the funds from the AMS grant. We received a refund from taxes during the Covid year. We are currently favorable on receipts for the first 7 months of 2023. We are a little behind on our giving to The ANSWER Center which we will be catching up in the next month. We are keeping a very close eye on our numbers. We are about \$1,100 ahead of last year on church giving.
- Mrs. Beverly Davis, WMU Coordinator, she expressed deep appreciation for all those participating in the C.R.O.S.S. Bible studies. Last year we filled 800 bags for the Christmas Jail Bag Ministry & we will be filling the ones for this year on December 5 at the Hyland Baptist Family Life Center.
- Dr. Bob Hardison, Foundation Team, presented an update on our Foundation funds. Our Foundation Team is about raising money to make it possible for people & church groups to participate in mission work. You are encouraged to leave a portion of your estate to your church & to the GVBA Foundation fund. This money is used only for mission work. The revenue we received this year was over \$3,000.00 to help our churches & individuals to participate in mission work. Our team would love to come to your church so we can share what the Foundation is all about.
- Bro. Bill Kramer, Disaster Relief Coordinator, a crew of 6 went to Florida during the hurricane. We had a group of 10 involved in Send Relief. They do weekend projects, we worked with them in April. We had about 700 meals served. We still have a couple of training courses left for this year. Next year, we will have one in Madisonville in March. We lost Lou Hopper this past year when God called him home. We need younger people to take over.
- Rev. Jeff Burke, GVBA Community Ministries Director, presented a report on the KJS ANSWER Center. He thanked everyone for their support. We have on average about 100 people on Saturdays. We have given out a second-hand vacuum & some gift cards from Sure Way. We lost Diane Rightmyer last month when God called her home. She was always a faithful volunteer. We ask you to continue to make donations, volunteer, & pray for this ministry.

Grace Point Mission Trip Presentation

Rev. Eric Fannin, Grace Point, shared about their mission trip to Northern Minnesota in June. We partner with Evangelism Unlimited & Cornerstone Baptist church & Northwoods Baptist Association. We were able to keep our cost down due to the GVBA Foundation. He thanked everyone who gives to the Foundation.

We were there to share the gospel of Jesus with so many that have never heard it. We did door to door evangelism close to the church. We are planning to go to International Falls, MN next year. We look to partner with 2 churches from Texas & our plan is to knock on every door & share the gospel. We were able to speak with over 80 people & we saw 3 pray to receive Christ as personal savior. At the racetrack we have about 50+ racetrack workers attending our services. He thanked the numerous churches for the delicious meals that the WMU provides, Bro. Paul Davis & Beverly of Spottsville, Dolores Gilmore, & Bro. Cohen for their tireless efforts & work at Ellis Park.

Rev. Dylan Zahn, FBC Sebree, brought a devotional from scripture passage from Revelation 1 starting in verse 9. He spoke on what a comfort it is that Jesus is still working in the life of the church.

Bro. Tim Wilkerson led us in singing “Blessed Assurance” & All Hail the Power of Jesus Name”. Bro. Tim had asked an eleven-year-old young man, Daniel Clutts, to play for our offertory music.

Bro. Cohen announced that the love offering we will be giving will go to Dr. Phillip Basinger, our GVBA AMS Emeritus. D.O.M. Emeritus, Dr. Phillip Basinger, was our former Associational Mission Strategist for 10 years and is also our former interim AMS. While they have relocated to Owensboro, they continue to be friends of the Association and fellow servants in the Kingdom. We count it our privilege to receive this evening’s love offering as an expression of appreciation of their faithfulness and their friendship. We received \$445.00.

We were so blessed in song by Ms. Stephanie Schinault, Bellfield.

Bro. Ron Crow, KBC Missions Mobilization Team, Disaster Relief Director, brought a message on the great things the Disaster Relief team is involved. He came to in 2021 as the DR Director. 100% of the funds received go directly to helping us help people as they face loss. In 2023 we have sent trained teams to 25 communities in Kentucky & four other states, Central Asia, Alaska & Puerto Rico. We help people with showers, washer/dryers, childcare, & much more. KBC has sent \$20,000 to help the GVBA Disaster Relief Team. KBC

is partnering with Canada to set up a trailer to help feed people facing disaster along with Tennessee. Ministry is about people. On March 31, a windstorm went through the Hopkinsville area. A small section of town had a lot of damage that had been overlooked initially. One of the main questions asked was “why did you come”. The answer was because God sent us. This was a small community of black citizens & the love they were shown helped to start to heal racial tensions. 41% of the world’s population is unreached. 30% of Americans have no religious affiliation at all. He read Matthew 9. Jesus is in the midst of His ministry, preaching, healing, teaching, & proclaiming the Gospel. Jesus’s ministry was focused on the people, taking care of their physical needs then the spiritual needs. We need to see as Jesus saw, feel as Jesus felt, so we will do as Jesus did. He encouraged us all to pray, pray for what God wants you to do. Pray for the workers in the field. Help those that are in need. Do everything in love giving God the glory always, sharing the Gospel & your personal testimony with those you meet. There are no small churches, just another outpost of the Kingdom of God. ASSOCIATIONAL MISSIONS STRATEGIST REPORT

Welcome to the 65th annual meeting of the Green Valley Baptist Association!

My brief tenure, which began May 01, 2023, has been a whirlwind as Angie and I have sought to visit as many churches as possible, as soon as possible. May through July, I traveled 2,080 ministry miles preaching or presenting a total of eleven times in eight of our churches. In our churches that held Vacation Bible School, I believe I was present at each VBS. My apologies if I missed anyone. Including worship services, presentations, VBS, senior adult activities, etc..., I have to date visited all but five of twenty-nine churches. In May, I attended an AMS Leadership Advance in Lexington, KY. In July, I attended New AMS Training in Louisville, KY. Both trainings were sponsored by the Kentucky Baptist Convention. I also attended a West Region AMS meeting in Princeton, KY in July.

There are some blanks where we looked at the history where no funds were being used from those line items. Line item #106 for TAC, this is now a percentage of undesignated gifts received. The giving to TAC will fluctuate. Disaster Relief & TAC have designated funds they operate from.

With no discussion, the 2023 budget was adopted with no opposition.

New Business

- The trustees of GVBA are recommending that we be allowed to spend up to \$100,000.00 from the building fund for upcoming repairs & improvements to the facility. After a short discussion, Bro. Paul Davis called for the question. motion carried with no opposition.

After several announcements a motion to adjourn was made by Rev. Paul Davis, Spottsville and seconded by Rev. Jeff Hesley, Robards. We were dismissed in prayer by Rev. Dylan Zahn, FBC Seabee.

There was a special-called meeting of the GVBA executive board on Thursday, March 2, 2023. There were eighteen (18) board members present representing eleven (11) churches.

Rev. Cole Caven, moderator, called the meeting to order.

Rev. Jeff Hesley, Robards, opened our meeting in prayer.

Rev. Cole Caven read the motion from the Advisory Team

- In light of the present level of giving in our Green Valley Baptist Association churches, our association will not be able to afford a full-time Associational Mission Strategist (AMS) and a full-time Ministry assistant. After praying and much discussion, the Advisory Team (Bod Hardison, John Kloke and Sam Hinkson) brings the following motion:

- *We, the Advisory Committee, move that the Green Valley Baptist Association employ a full-time Associational Mission Strategist (AMS) and change the Ministry Assistant to a part-time position. The Ministry Assistant is to work three (3) hours a day, Monday through Thursday, with the pay of \$20 an hour. The benefits for this position will be adjusted to that of a part-time position.*

Furthermore, the Ministry Assistant and the custodial job is to be separated with different individuals working them. The custodian will work four hours a week cleaning the facility.

If this motion passes, these directives will take affect ninety (90) days after this vote by the GVBA Executive Board.

After some discussion, the motion passed.

The second motion from the Advisory Team reads as follows:

- ***The Advisory Team moves that the Green Valley Baptist Association request the Kentucky Baptist Convention to include our association in their Associational Mission Strategist salary assistance program for the next five years. This program will provide salary assistance for our AMS at eh rate of \$1,200 a month (a total of \$14,400 a year). This amount from the KBC will decrease 20% per year until it fades out in five years. This request is to be made immediately.***

With a little discussion for clarification, the motion passed unanimously.

Bro. Rick Crowder, Finance Team, presented the revised budget for 2023.

After a time of questions & discussion, the motion to approve the revised budget for 2023 passed with no opposition.

Greetings from The Kathy J. Strange ANSWER Center.

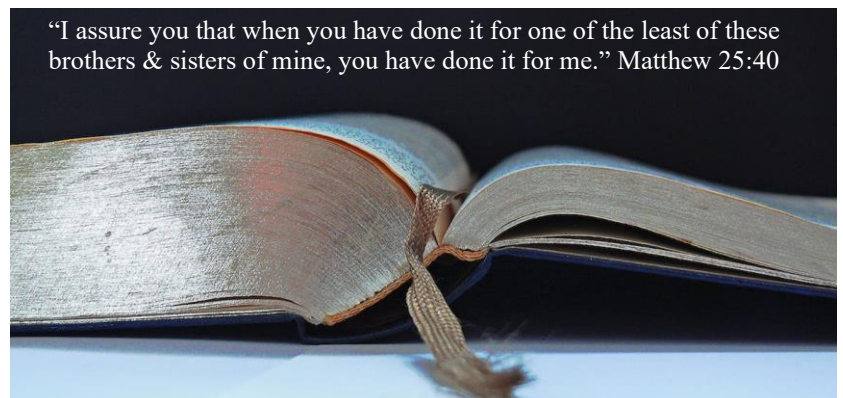
Since opening for the first time on November 12, 2022, at our new location, we have helped at least 1,565 people on Saturdays and close to 100 during the week. We have been blessed with at least 88 volunteers including 27 teenagers. Our volunteers work not only on Saturdays, but also during the week on Mondays and Thursdays sorting donations and getting The ANSWER Center ready for Saturday shopping. Our volunteers have worked at least 1,384 hours. There are likely more hours worked because some of our volunteers do not sign in and some don't put down the number of hours worked.

This past Christmas, we gave away 172 Christmas backpacks and 88 Easter baskets at Easter. Most importantly, we have seen 12 people pray to receive Christ on Saturdays. We praise God for all that have been saved. This is why we do what we do.

Here are a few things you can do to help us:

1. Pray for us – nothing is more helpful for this ministry than your prayers.
2. We need donations of men's, women's, and children's clothing. Some of our donations go into our semi-trailer to be shipped overseas, but most of it remains here to stock our shelves for when we open on Saturdays for shopping.
3. Volunteer – 88 volunteers sounds like a lot of volunteers, but many of these can only come occasionally and we usually have the same volunteers every Saturday we are open. If we had more volunteers on Saturdays, we probably could open more than twice a month and could possibly help more people.
4. In September, give to the Eliza Broadus Offering. In February of this year, we received another \$2,500 EBO grant. That grant money comes from Kentucky Baptists all across the state. When you give, you support not only us, but also other ministries across the state of Kentucky.

Advisory Team Report

The Advisory Team met several times in the past several months. We have had to make some very difficult decisions such as changing the position of the Ministry Assistant from a full-time position to twelve hours a week. The MA now works three hours per day four days each week. Karen has chosen to continue in this position. As an expression of appreciation of Dr. Phillip Basinger's leadership and service as Interim AMS, we will receive a love offering for him and Mollie during the worship session of this year's annual meeting.
