# The Subjunctive ‘Mood’ Used To Cast Prophetic Visions!

**Subjunctive mood** = casts a doubtful, not-based-on fact yet. Could become true, but not yet.

“I have a dream that my four little children will one day in a nation where they will not be judged by the color of their skin but by the content of their character”



# “Let Us Draw Near” vs. 22

Draw near = “to move continuously toward”

ILLUSTRATION: A drinking straw

The Lord’s will is drawing you today!

\* character +

\* behavior – Eph.1:3-4

# The Admonition to Draw Near...

**\*\* How?**

**\*\* Put aside distractions**

**\*\* Pay attention to voice of the Lord  
(The Word: John 6:68)**

**\*\* Focus: the cross! John 12:32**

**Choices:**

**\* go with the flow – i.e. submit to His will**

**OR**

**\* resist – delay for worldly purposes**

**Non-cooperation = disobedience!**

# **“Let Us Consider How To Stimulate”**

**Vs. 24 – “to love and good deeds” **Hmmm.****

- \* T-shirt dresses (3,000+ dresses later)**
- \* Back-pack ministry (26 avg./ week, \$800)**
- \* AWANA for children (40’s avg.)**
- \* Chris Gaunt 5K (6 yrs + \$24,000 later)**

**Or what about widows with repair issues?**

**Or women caught up sex trafficking?**
