Recently someone sent me an article by Josh Daffern of some church traditions that need to be changed. In Acts 6, Stephen (the first Christian martyr) was on trial for challenging the religious traditions of his day. *They seized Stephen and brought him before the Sanhedrin. They produced false witnesses, who testified, "This fellow never stops speaking against this holy place and against the law. For we have heard him say that this Jesus of Nazareth will destroy this place and change the customs Moses handed down to us"* (Acts 6:12-14).

Here are some traditions that need to be changed.

1. *Agreeing with the Word of God rather than obeying it.* We're great about agreeing with the Word of God. Obedience, however, is a different matter. We need to start obeying it.

2. *Getting disciplined rather than making disciples.* In the Great Commission Jesus is explicit: "Go, make disciples." Daffern takes this command to go with Acts 1:8 ("you will be my witnesses.") Do you want our church to grow? Be a witness to the lost and the unchurched.

3. *Judging the world rather than loving it.* Paul said in 1<sup>st</sup> Corinthians 5:12, "What business is it of mine to judge those outside the church?" This is an application of Jesus' command, "love one another." Remember, "We exist to LOVE and serve God and ALL PEOPLE."

4. *Living in spite of eternity, rather than in light of eternity.* We live like heaven isn't really going to happen. Just look at how we spend our time and resources. We spend the majority of our incomes on ourselves, our pleasures, making ourselves comfortable in this world. We've completely forgotten Jesus' command to store up for ourselves treasures in heaven, not on earth.

I have shared these observations for you to consider. What traditions do you agree need to be changed? What can you do to make the changes necessary in your own life?
