Him in my soul

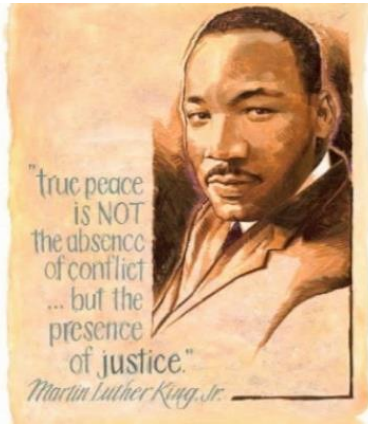
Some folks may doubt

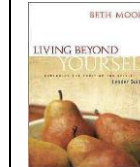
Winter Leadership Summit
