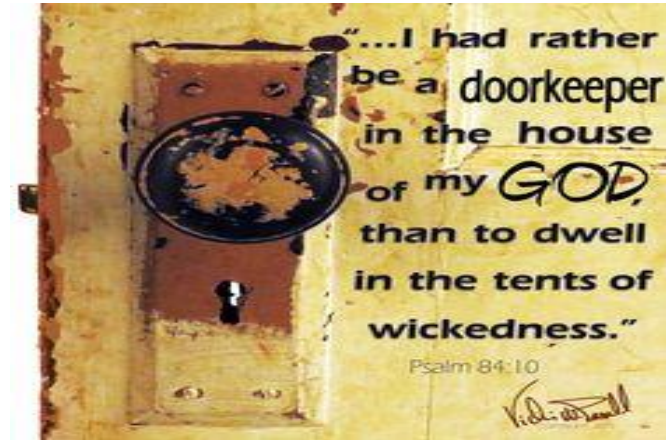

Worship Leader:
