<i>January</i>	Chapstick	<u>Socks of Love</u> Please bring in socks appropriate for both men and women. (no footies, please)
<i>February</i>	Non-perishable food items: Granola bars, pudding cups, Vienna sausages, cans of soup or ravioli with pop lids, crackers, etc.	
<i>March</i>	Deodorant, hand sanitizer, tooth paste (we have enough tooth brushes),	<u>Hygiene blessing bags</u> Bring in gently used or new bags, back packs, or drawstring bags.
<i>April</i>	Travel size shampoo, Band-Aids, feminine products, nail clippers	
<i>May</i>	Underwear: men's size large	<u>Water Bottle Care Packs</u> Bring in reusable water bottles with a wide, screw on lid. We will fill these with care items.
<i>June</i>	New or gently used hats, rain ponchos (dollar store)	
<i>July</i>	Non-perishable food items (see above for suggestions)	<u>Sheltered in Place</u> Bring in 6 x 8 ft (approximate) tarps with grommets or donate \$ and we can order them in bulk
<i>August</i>	Razors, shaving cream, zippered pencil bags	
<i>September</i>	Handwarmers (like the ones used for hunting)	<u>Covered in Love</u> Bring in new or gently used throws, blankets, etc.
<i>October</i>	Sock caps, gloves	
<i>November</i>	Travel coffee cups, Christmas stockings	<u>All Bundled Up!</u> Bring in new or gently used sleeping bags
