



What is Awana?

Awana is an international, Bible-centered children's and youth ministry providing local churches with weekly clubs, programs, and training for students in preschool through high school. Our goal is to equip churches to reach children and teenagers, and their families, with the gospel of Christ and train them to serve Him. The acronym Awana comes from the first letters of Approved Workmen Are Not Ashamed as taken from **2 Timothy 2:15.**

Cubbies – Pre-school Club (ages 3 & 4) - Our preschool program offers the 4 F's... Fun – and lots of it, Friendly characters and leaders, Foundational teaching, & Family involvement. Your kids will reap immediate benefits from their involvement in this exciting program. Just look at what they will learn after only two years: Approximately 55 memory verses – and up to 120 additional verses if they complete our extra-credit curriculum; Key basic truths about God, Jesus Christ, salvation, and the Bible; and the Gospel message and their need to trust Christ as Savior.



Sparks – Kindergarten – Second Grade – The sparks program is firmly grounded in Scripture. The three handbooks feature: Basic truths about God, Jesus Christ, salvation, and the Bible; An increased emphasis on Scripture memory over our preschool materials. In three years, a child will learn and review 68 verses, many of which cover salvation and key Christian doctrine; and clear and consistent presentation of the gospel message.

Truth in Training (TNT) – Third – Sixth Grades – The name Truth in Training reflects the passion of Awana to teach third through sixth grade boys and girls the truth of God's Word and to train them to follow Christ in their daily lives. By the time a child has completed TNT, he will have learned and reviewed approximately 310 verses; studied dozens of passages from the Old and New Testament; regularly heard and read the gospel message; discovered the Bible's response to questions like "How does God want me to live my life?" and memorized verses to back up these answers; and completed missions projects that help him see the world through God's eyes.



We also have the Trek Club for 7th & 8th grades. Awana is on Wednesday evenings from 6:00 pm until 7:30 pm. Each club meets for an hour and then all join together for Game Time (except for the Cubbies). Awana follows the same schedule as the school system...no school means no Awana.
