

Amazon Kindle Checklist

Find something already selling

- High number of reviews
- Communities or membership sites around topic
- Blogs writing about topic

Look at other's table of contents.

- Get inspired by their topic

Read negative reviews.

- Look at the disappointments and gaps that people are writing about in their reviews.

Do some research and knowledge acquisition

- Read top 3 books in niche/topic
- Read top 3 blogs in niche/topic
- Search for 3 forums in niche/topic

Make a 15-30 chapter outline.

- Estimate you can have 1,000 words for each chapter

Add 4 bullet-points to each chapter

- Breaking your book down into smaller sections will help you a lot when it comes to writing.
- Each 1,000 word chapter can contain four 250 word sections. Write out each chapter

Write Book

- First Draft is A Brain Dump
 - Don't think. Just write.
- Second Draft is for details
- Third Draft for Review
- Finalize for copyedit

Hire a copyeditor to check your writing

- You can hire an editor from various freelancing sites.

Finalize and publish on Amazon Kindle

- Get your book formatted correctly and published on kindle.
 - Use KindleGen or Kindle PreviewerConsider enrolling in KDP select for a few months and running a free download offer in order to get the book into more hands.
