CATS AIM TO REACH BOWL ELIGIBILITY FOR FOURTH STRAIGHT YEAR

Kentucky returns home for the final two weeks of the regular season needing just one victory to become bowl eligible for the fourth consecutive season. The first opportunity comes in the form of UT Martin on Saturday afternoon. The game is set for a 3:30 p.m. ET kickoff and will air on the SEC Network.

The Cats are riding a wave of momentum after grinding Vanderbilt to a pulp in a 38-14 victory in Nashville that saw the rushing attack pile up 401 yards. Moreover, UK erased a 14-3 first quarter deficit in doing so, scoring the game's final 35 points to secure it's largest SEC road win since 2001.

Lynn Bowden Jr. continued his onslaught on defenses with his fourth 100-yard rushing game in five starts at quarterback, tying Mike Fanuzzi for the most by a QB in school history. His 723 rushing yards in UK's last five SEC games this season are the most by a Wildcat in the last five SEC games of a season in school history.

The UK defense also has shown stark improvement and continues to give the team a chance to win despite its inexperience on that side of the ball, particularly in the secondary. It has held five consecutive SEC opponents to 305 total yards or less, the best such stretch since 1977, and allowed just 198 total yards to Vanderbilt.

QUICK NOTES

- Kentucky is 5-5 on the season and 3-5 in SEC play.
- Lynn Bowden Jr. has turned in impressive effort since shifting over to play quarterback due to injuries, delivering a virtuoso performance with 196 rushing yards and two touchdowns against Arkansas and 204 rushing yards and two scores against Missouri, both wins. Bowden earned SEC Offensive Player of the Week honors for both efforts.
- Bowden, a Paul Hornung Award finalist for the nation's most versatile athlete, ranks tenth nationally and leads the SEC in all-purpose yards, averaging 142.3 yards per game.
- Bowden is the only player in FBS to lead his team in both rushing and receiving yards this season.
- In five starts at QB he has recorded four 100-yard rushing games and is averaging 144.6 yards per game on the ground (723 total rushing yards). That ties him with Mike Fanuzzi for the most by a quarterback in school history.
- He ranks 10th in school history in career all-purpose yards (3,994) and fifth in most before their senior season.
- Bowden and Randall Cobb are the only two players in UK history to reach 1,000-career rushing, 1,000-career receiving and 1,000-career return yards.
- His 204 rushing yards vs. Missouri are the second-most for a quarterback in UK history. Coupled with his 196 vs. Arkansas he now has two of the top three QB rushing efforts at UK.
- Bowden reached 1,000 career receiving yards in the season opener and 100 career receptions vs. Florida. He had 210 all-purpose yards vs. Mississippi State.
- Against South Carolina, Bowden became the second FBS player since 2000 to have at least six rushing attempts, three receptions, three kickoff returns, and two passing completions in a single game (also Kalen Ballage, Arizona State vs. Oregon, Oct. 29, 2016).
- Junior punter Max Duffy has been sensational, ranking second in FBS in punting at 48.3 yards per kick. He was named the Ray Guy Award Punter of the Week for his performance at South Carolina on Sept. 28 and again for his effort vs. Missouri on Oct. 26.
- Duffy is the school's all-time leading punter at 46.2 yards per kick.
- With Duffy's punting and hustling coverage by the punt team, UK leads the nation with 45.36 net yards per punt.
- Kentucky has held five consecutive SEC opponents to 305 yards of total offense or less for the first time since 1977.

- Since 2016, UK is 12-6 in games decided by seven points or less.
- The Cats now are 15-8 over their past 23 games.
- UK has a 16-16 SEC record over the past four seasons. It is the first time since 1953-56 that the Wildcats have won at least half of their conference games over a four-year stretch.
- UK has allowed 24 points or less in 22 of its last 25 games. That is the best such stretch since October 14, 1978 to Sept. 6, 1980. UK allowed 24 points or less in 18 of 19 games in that stretch.
- UK has allowed 34 points or less in 24 straight games, the longest active streak in the nation. It is the longest for Kentucky since a 45-game streak from 1976-80.
- The Cats only allowed a total of three points in the first half of three straight SEC games (at Georgia, Missouri, Tennessee), the best mark since allowing a total of three points against three consecutive SEC opponents (Georgia, Vanderbilt, Florida) in 1988.
- UK is tied for fifth in the FBS, and second in the SEC, in fewest plays from scrimmage of at least 40 yards allowed (four).
- UK is tied for third in the FBS, and tied for first in the SEC, in fewest passing plays of at least 40 yards allowed (one).
- Kentucky is second in the FBS, and second in the SEC, in running plays of at least 20 yards (32).
- UK is tied for first in the FBS, and first in the SEC, in fewest passing touchdowns allowed (six).
- UK's rushing offense ranks second in the SEC and 16th nationally at 231.4 yards per game.
- UK is one of just 22 FBS teams to have three players with a 100-yard rushing game this year.
- Defensive end Calvin Taylor Jr. has a team-high 6.0 sacks, which ranks tied for third in the SEC. His three forced fumbles is tied for the most in the league and 10th nationally.
- This is coach Mark Stoops' seventh season in Lexington and the Wildcats have either matched or exceeded the previous season's win total in each of the past six seasons, making them the only program in FBS to accomplish that feat.
- During Stoops' tenure the Wildcats have had eight different starting quarterbacks win a game.
- Kentucky has played 11 true freshmen (Jared Casey, M.J. Devonshire, Taj Dodson, Moses Douglass, Jalen Geiger, DeMarcus Harris, K.D. McDaniel, Nik Ogenovic, Travis Tisdale, J.J. Weaver and Tra Wilkins) and 14 redshirt freshmen in at least one game this season.
- Stoops has 41 wins during his tenure, tied for the third-most in school history with Jerry Claiborne and Blanton Collier. Stoops also has 30 wins at Kroger Field, the second-most wins in the current stadium.
- Stoops' "recruit and develop" mentality culminated in 2018 with a 10-3 record, UK's best season in 41 years and only the third 10-win season in school history. UK's 5-3 SEC record also was the team's first winning league mark since 1977. The Cats finished second in the SEC Eastern Division.

SCOUTING UT MARTIN

- UT Martin is 7-4 on the season, including a 6-2 mark in Ohio Valley Conference play.
- This will be the SkyHawks' final game of the regular season.
- The teams have one common opponent - Florida. The SkyHawks lost 45-0 in Gainesville, while UK lost 29-21 in Lexington.
- Quarterback John Bochus has thrown for 2,392 yards and 18 touchdowns against just eight interceptions this season. He also has rushed for three touchdowns.
- Running back Peyton Logan leads the team with 78.4 rushing yards per game and six scores on the ground.
- UT Martin has a pair of dangerous receivers in Terry Williams and Colton Dowell. Williams has hauled in 50 passes but may be even more of a threat in the return game where he has taken two punts back for scores and averages over 23 yards per kick return. Dowell is averaging nearly 21 yards per catch.
- Linebacker T.J. Jefferson stands just 5-foot-8 but he's a monster on the field. he has 91 total tackles, 8.5 TFL, 4.5 sacks, 11 quarterback hurries, a forced fumble and a fumble recovery.

SERIES VS. UT MARTIN

- Kentucky leads the all-time series 1-0, defeating UT Martin 59-14 to open the 2014 season.
- The victory opened UK coach Mark Stoops' second season at the helm.
- It remains the second-largest margin of victory during Stoops' tenure.
- UK quarterback Patrick Towles passed for 377 yards in that game, the second-highest total of the Stoops era and second-most since 2007.
- Former Wildcats Za'Darius Smith and Bud Dupree are tearing up the NFL these days but both players were on the field in blue that day. Dupree logged two sacks among his four tackles while Smith tallied five tackles.

KENTUCKY-UT MARTIN CONNECTIONS

- Kentucky has three players on its roster from the state of Tennessee: DL Quinton Bohanna (Cordova), OT Darian Kinnard (Knoxville), and DB Jaylen Scott (Clarksville).
- UT Martin has two players from the Commonwealth on its roster: OL Chris Jackson (Lexington) and DB Jack Lucas (Louisville).
- UK quality control coach Mark Perry coached UTM offensive lineman Chris Jackson at Lexington Catholic High School.

A UK WIN WOULD...

- Make Kentucky bowl eligible for the fourth consecutive season.
- Give Kentucky its eighth straight non-conference win.
- Make the Cats 14-3 in their past 17 non-conference games.
- Give coach Mark Stoops 42 career victories at UK, moving him into second place on the school's all-time list behind Paul "Bear" Bryant (60) and Fran Curci (47).
- Give Stoops 31 wins at Kroger Field, two shy of Paul "Bear" Bryant's (1946-53) school-record mark for home wins.
- Improve UK's all-time record at Kroger Field to 167-135-4.

BOW DOWN TO BOWDEN

- Junior athlete Lynn Bowden Jr. has his explosive playmaking and versatility to another level since shifting to quarterback full-time the past three games. He has twice been named SEC Offensive Player of the Week while delivering two of the top three rushing performance for a quarterback in school history and just the ninth-ever 200-yard rushing game by a UK player.
- He is a finalist for the Paul Hornung Award for the nation's most versatile athlete.
- In those five games he has tallied 723 rushing yards, the most by a Wildcat in the last five SEC games of a season in school history.
- In five starts at QB he has recorded four 100-yard rushing games and is averaging 144.6 yards per game on the ground (723 total rushing yards).
- His four 100-yard rushing games as a quarterback ties Mike Fanuzzi for the UK career record.
- He is currently averaging 7.0 yards per rush, right in line with Stanley "Boom" Williams' school-record 7.1 pace. The 7.0 yards per carry ranks third nationally this season.
- In UK's rain-soaked 29-7 win over Mizzou on Oct. 26 he rushed for 204 yards and two scores. It was the top single-game rushing performance by an SEC player this season at the time.
- It is the most rushing yards for a Wildcat vs. an SEC opponent since Rafael Little ran for 198 yards at Vanderbilt in 2005.
- It is the second-most for a UK quarterback in school history. Mike Fanuzzi ran for 208 yards vs. Miami (Ohio) in 1974.
- In the Cats' 24-20 win over Arkansas on Oct. 12, shifting over to make his first start at quarterback due to injuries to Terry Wilson and Sawyer Smith. He rushed 24 times for 196 yards and two touchdowns.

- Because of his dominant performance, Bowden earned SEC Co-Offensive Player of the Week, his second Paul Hornung Award Weekly Honor Roll honor and the Manning Award National Quarterback of the Week.
- He is the first UK quarterback with two rushing and one passing touchdown in a game since Patrick Towles vs. Mississippi State in 2014.
- Against Vanderbilt he both rushed and passed for over 100 yards.
- Bowden ranks tenth nationally at 142.3 all-purpose yards per game.
- FBS players since 2000 to have at least 20 rushing attempts, 10 passing attempts, and a punt return in the same game: Antwaan Randle El (Indiana), Julian Edelman (Kent State), Bowden.
- Bowden and Randall Cobb are the only two players in UK history to reach 1,000-career rushing, 1,000-career receiving and 1,000-career return yards. Those two are joined by Rafael Little and Anthony White as the only four players in school history to have 1,000-career rushing and 1,000-career receiving yards.
- Bowden was a First-Team Midseason All-America selection as an all-purpose player by ESPN and the Associated Press.

DOMINANT DUFFY

- UK punter Max Duffy continues to be an absolute weapon for the Cats, dominating the field position game with his booming and accurate leg. The Australian punter and Ray Guy Award candidate has the UK career record, averaging 46.2 on 102 kicks.
- Duffy was named the Ray Guy Award Punter of the Week for both week five and week nine.
- In week five he set two school records in the Sept. 28 game against South Carolina: He broke his own single-game school record (min. 8 punts), averaging 51.1 yards on nine kicks...For the game, had four punts inside the 20 with no touchbacks and his net average was 51.3 yards per punt... Created a turnover as he had one punt that hit a South Carolina player and was recovered by the Wildcats...All five punts that originated from at least the UK 27-yard line ended up inside the Gamecock 20 ... During that game he also became UK's career punting average leader.
- In week nine he punted five times for 262 yards and a 52.4 average, had a career-best 70-yard punt and pinned Mizzou inside its own 20-yard line three times. Duffy's 70-yard punt was the longest by a UK player in an SEC game since Ryan Tydlacka vs. Ole Miss in 2010 (73 yards)... Duffy also scampered 26 yards for a first down on a fake punt. It kept the drive alive that set up Kentucky's final touchdown.
- Duffy was a First-Team Midseason All-America choice by ESPN and The Sporting News and Second-Team Midseason All-America selection by the Associated Press.

LAST SATURDAY

- Kentucky dominated Vanderbilt, 38-14, in Nashville for the first road win of the season.
- The Cats erased a 14-3 first half deficit by scoring the game's final 35 points.
- The Cats completed their SEC portion of the schedule with a 3-5 record despite multiple injuries at quarterback throughout the campaign.
- It was UK's largest SEC road win since in 18 years. The Cats defeated Vanderbilt 56-30 in Nashville in 2001. It is the third-largest since 1979.
- UK had a season-high 528 yards total offense, best since compiling 601 at Louisville last season.
- UK had 401 rushing yards, most since rushing for 443 at Tennessee in 2016.
- UK allowed just 198 yards, the fifth consecutive SEC game that UK has limited the opponent to 305 or fewer yards. It is the fewest offensive yards allowed since limiting Vanderbilt to 139

PASCHAL NAMED NOMINEE FOR MAYO CLINIC COMEBACK PLAYER OF THE YEAR AND CAPITAL ONE ORANGE BOWL-FWAA COURAGE AWARD

- Joshua Paschal, a sophomore outside linebacker, has made an inspiring return to the football field after overcoming a malignant melanoma that appeared on the bottom of his right foot just before training camp was to open in July of 2018. He underwent three surgeries and monthly immunotherapy treatments for more than a year before being cleared in August. His final treatment was Aug. 7, 2019. He's now a nominee for both the Mayo Clinic Comeback Player of the Year Award and the Capital One Orange Bowl-FWAA Courage Award.
- He battled back to return on a limited basis for the final three games of the 2018 season and has made an immediate impact this season. Paschal, who was voted a team captain by his peers, has started in all 10 games for the Wildcats this season. He has totaled 29 tackles, 6.0 tackles for loss, 2.0 sacks, a pass breakup, a forced fumble and his second career blocked punt in his return.

BOWDEN, DUFFY NAMED MIDSEASON ALL-AMERICANS

Kentucky juniors Lynn Bowden Jr. and Max Duffy have been named midseason All-Americans by The Associated Press and ESPN. On the AP team, Bowden was named to the first team as an all-purpose player, while Duffy earned second-team honors as a punter. Duffy was also named a midseason All-American by Sporting News.

- Bowden currently leads the SEC and ranks 10th nationally in all-purpose yards, averaging 142.3 per game.
- Earned several honors after his thrilling performance vs. Arkansas, including All-SEC Co-Offensive Player of the Week, Paul Hornung Honor Roll and a Manning Award "Star of the Week"
- Accounted for 274 yards of total offense and all three touchdowns in his first collegiate start as a quarterback ... Connected on 7 of 11 passes for 78 yards and his first career scoring pass, and also rushed a career-high

- Followed that up with an even better performance in a win over Missouri, also earning him SEC Offensive Player of the Week and Paul Hornung Honor Roll. He rang up 204 rushing yards and two scores, the second-most rushing yards by a quarterback in UK history and just the ninth time a UK player has gone over the 200-yard mark in a game.
- Bowden is UK's leading receiver with 30 catches for 348 yards and one TD this season
- Currently ranks 13th on UK's career receptions list and is 18th on the career receiving yards list with 1,303 yards
- Leads the team in kick returns with eight for 200 yards (25.0) and punt returns with four for 53 yards (13.2)
- Duffy ranks second nationally in punting at 48.3 yards per punt.
- Has been consistently dominant and earned Ray Guy Award Punter of the Week for week five vs. South Carolina when he broke his own single-game record (min. eight punts) by averaging 51.1 yards on nine kicks.
- He followed that up by winning it again in week nine after averaging 52.4 average, had a career-best 70-yard punt and pinned Mizzou inside its own 20-yard line three times. Duffy's 70-yard punt was the longest by a UK player in an SEC game since Ryan Tydlacka vs. Ole Miss in 2010 (73 yards)... Duffy also scampered 26 yards for a first down on a fake punt. It kept the drive alive that set up Kentucky's final touchdown.
