

## Lily of the Valley Earrings

## Materials



StormDuo Beads  
Approx. 20 pieces

Eye Pins  
2 pieces



IrisDuo Beads  
Approx. 10 pieces

Earwires  
2 pieces



Miyuki Drops 3.4 mm  
Approx. 12 pieces

Wildfire Thread .006




Miyuki Seed Beads 11/0  
Approx. 1 gram

Needle size 10




Miyuki Seed Beads 15/0  
Approx. 2 grams

**Step 1:** Thread a needle onto an arm span length of thread. Pick up (5) 11/0's. Slide the beads down, leaving a short thread tail. Knot the beads into a circle. Go through the 11/0 next to the knot. Pick up (1) 11/0 and sew into the next 11/0, five times. Step up by going through the first 11/0 you added.




**Step 2:** From here you are going to do the Herringbone stitch. Add (2) 15/0's and sew into the 11/0, five times. Step up by going through the first 15/0 you added. Pick up (2) 15/0's and sew into the second 15/0 as well as the first 15/0 in the next set of (2) 15/0's, five times. Don't forget to pull your thread tight. Step up by going through the first 15/0 you added.


**Step 3:** Add (2) 15/0's and sew into the second 15/0. Pick up (1) 15/0 and sew up through the 15/0 in the next set of (2) 15/0's. Repeat this four more times. Step up by going through the first 15/0 you added. Add (2) 15/0's and sew into the second 15/0. Pick up (1) 11/0 and go up through the 15/0 in the next set of (2) 15/0's. Continue adding beads the entire way around. Step up by going through the first 15/0 you added in this row.




**Step 4:** Add (2) 15/0's and sew into the second 15/0, the 11/0 from the previous row and the 15/0 in the next set of (2) 15/0's, five times. Step up by going through the first 15/0 you added. Pick up (1) 11/0 and sew into the second 15/0, the 11/0 and the 15/0 in the next set of (2) 15/0's, five times. Step up by going through the first 11/0 you added.



**Step 5:** Pick up (1) IrisDuo and sew into the next 11/0, five times. Go through the first IrisDuo you added and sew into the second hole of that bead. Add (1) StormDuo, (1) 15/0, (1) StormDuo and sew into the IrisDuo, five times. Go through the first StormDuo and the 15/0 you added.



**Step 6:** Pick up (4) 15/0's and sew into the top hole of the next StormDuo. \* Add (2) 15/0's, (1) Drop, (1) 15/0 and slide the beads down next to the StormDuo. Go through the first 15/0 you just added and the next StormDuo. Pick up (4) 15/0's and sew into the 15/0 between the StormDuos. Sew back into the 15/0 you just added. Pick up (3) 15/0's and sew into the StormDuo. Repeat from \* the entire way around.



When you add the last (3) 15/0's, sew into the first 15/0 from the beginning of this row as well as the 15/0 between the StormDuos. Tie off your thread and burn down the extra thread.

**Step 7:** Take your Eye pin and go through the hole between the beads, from the inside towards the outside. Put on (1) 11/0. With Flat Nose Pliers bend the wire back, making a 90 degree angle. Take your Round Nose Pliers and make a loop. Attach an Earwire to the Eye pin.

Repeat Steps 1-7 to make another earring.
