### Tentative cost estimates of the Conference

#### Note by the Secretary-General

1. This note provides the Preparatory Committee with information concerning the estimated cost of some conference services in the Chinese language, should they be requested. For the purposes of compiling these estimates it has been assumed that approximately fifteen pages of important documentation would be required to be translated daily. It has also been assumed that interpretation would be provided for Chinese participants.

2. Provision of the above services in Chinese for a conference at Headquarters would involve only salary or contractual services costs. However, in view of the fact that the United Nations Office at Geneva has no Chinese language servicing staff, it would probably be necessary, should it be decided to hold the conference there, to send the staff required from New York, with the resulting travel and related costs as given below.
