Revised cost estimates (A/CONF.35/PC/L.4/Rev.1)

The revised cost estimates were approved.

The CHAIRMAN suggested that the revised cost estimates should be annexed to the report of the Preparatory Committee.

It was so decided.

ADOPTION OF THE REPORT OF THE PREPARATORY COMMITTEE

Mr. LAI (Malaysia), Rapporteur, introduced the draft report, which he had prepared with the assistance of the Secretariat, and suggested certain drafting changes. He also suggested that the report should include a reference to the two papers he had submitted as Committee documents: "Jecunity guarantees in the context of measures to prevent the spread of nuclear weapons" (A/CONF.35/PC/L.14) and "The peaceful uses of nuclear energy in the context of measures to prevent the spread of nuclear weapons" (A/CONF.35/PC/L.15).

 $\underline{\text{Mr. MOHAMMED}}$  (Nigeria) proposed that the two papers submitted by the Rapporteur should be annexed to the report.

It was so decided.

The draft report was adopted with the drafting changes.
