

**GOD
IS
NOT
ANGRY**

“For Christ, then, are we ambassadors, as of God entreating through us. We are beseeching for Christ’s sake, *‘Be conciliated to God!’* For the One not knowing sin, He makes to be a sin offering for our sakes that we may be becoming *God’s righteousness* in Him.”—2 Corinthians 5:20-21

IF, because of the sin offering of Christ, we may be becoming *God's righteousness* in Him, what is left for us to do? Christ has given us His word, on the cross— “It is *finished!*” God tells us that He was “in Christ, conciliating the world to Himself, *not reckoning* their offenses to them.” (2 Corinthians 5:19). He declares, and even *entreats* that we “be conciliated” to Him. He is *not* angry. He is at peace, because of the shed blood of Christ.

Your salvation is a FACT! God, through Christ, has *already* done everything to provide it. Christ became a sin offering for your sake, that you might be becoming God's righteousness in Him.

“For in grace, through faith, are you saved, and this is not out of you; it is God's approach present, not of works, lest anyone should be boasting.” (Ephesians 2:8,9).

“Yet when the kindness and fondness for humanity of our Saviour, God, made its advent, not for works which are wrought in righteousness which we do, but according to His mercy, He saves us . . .” (Titus 3:4,5).

There is nothing for you to *do*. There is nothing you *could* do. Salvation is yours *now!* Believe it! Receive it!

Not only have you been saved by His grace; but you have been *justified* in God's sight! “For we are reckoning a man to be justified by faith apart from works of law” (Romans 3:28).

“Being, then, justified by faith, we may be having *peace* toward God, through our Lord, Jesus Christ, through Whom we have the access, by faith, into this grace in which we stand, and we may be glorying in expectation of the glory of God” (Romans 5:1,2).
