5 Field Inspections Events

To become an Illinois-licensed home inspector, you must:

- 1. Successfully complete an approved pre-licensing course; including five field inspections
- 2. Pass the Illinois Home Inspector License Exam; and
- 3. Submit the certificate of pre-licensing completion, this field inspection form, license application, and fee to the state.

License applicants must select a supervising instructor from the list of possible instructors found on InterNACHI's website. License applicants are able to perform only one field inspection per day. Using any non-approved instructor or performing more than one field inspection per day could result in the state denying the license application.

License applicants must have their **supervising home inspector submit this form** fully completed to InterNACHI. Please scan and email to education@internachi.org. Do not mail this information.

"Field Inspection Event" means an examination and evaluation of the exterior and interior components of an actual residential property conducted by a candidate for a home inspection license under the supervision of a currently licensed home inspector.
