

School District Blended Learning Declaration Form

Any local, city, exempted village, or joint vocational school district established under Ohio Revised Code Chapter 3314, STEM school established under Chapter 3326, college-preparatory boarding school established under Chapter 3328, or chartered nonpublic school MUST notify the Ohio Department of Education no later than July 1 if the school, during the upcoming school year, will begin or cease to use a blended instructional model.¹

According to Ohio law², “blended learning” means the delivery of instruction in a combination of time in a supervised physical location away from home and online delivery whereby the student has some element of control over time, place, path or pace of learning.

To notify the Ohio Department of Education of a school’s intent to use or discontinue a blended learning model for a local, city, exempted village, or joint vocational school district, STEM school established under Chapter 3326. of the Revised Code, college-preparatory boarding school established under Chapter 3328. of the Revised Code, or chartered nonpublic school, complete the following and email the form to lily.bartholomew@education.ohio.gov.
