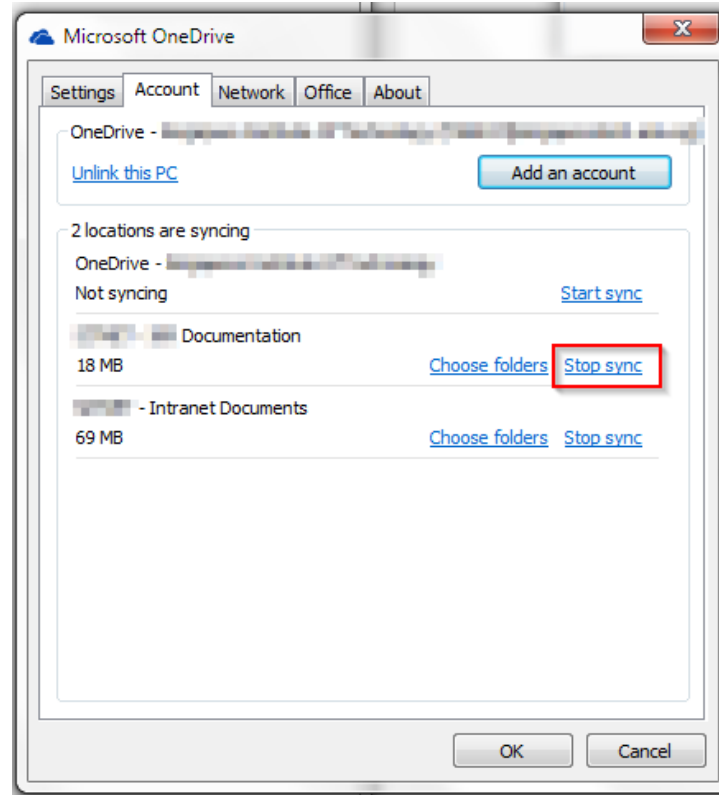
Curious, found out that all the files and folders having its **Write** permission set to **Deny** automatically. Let's proof it's automatic.

Let's stop the sync of the problematic document library.

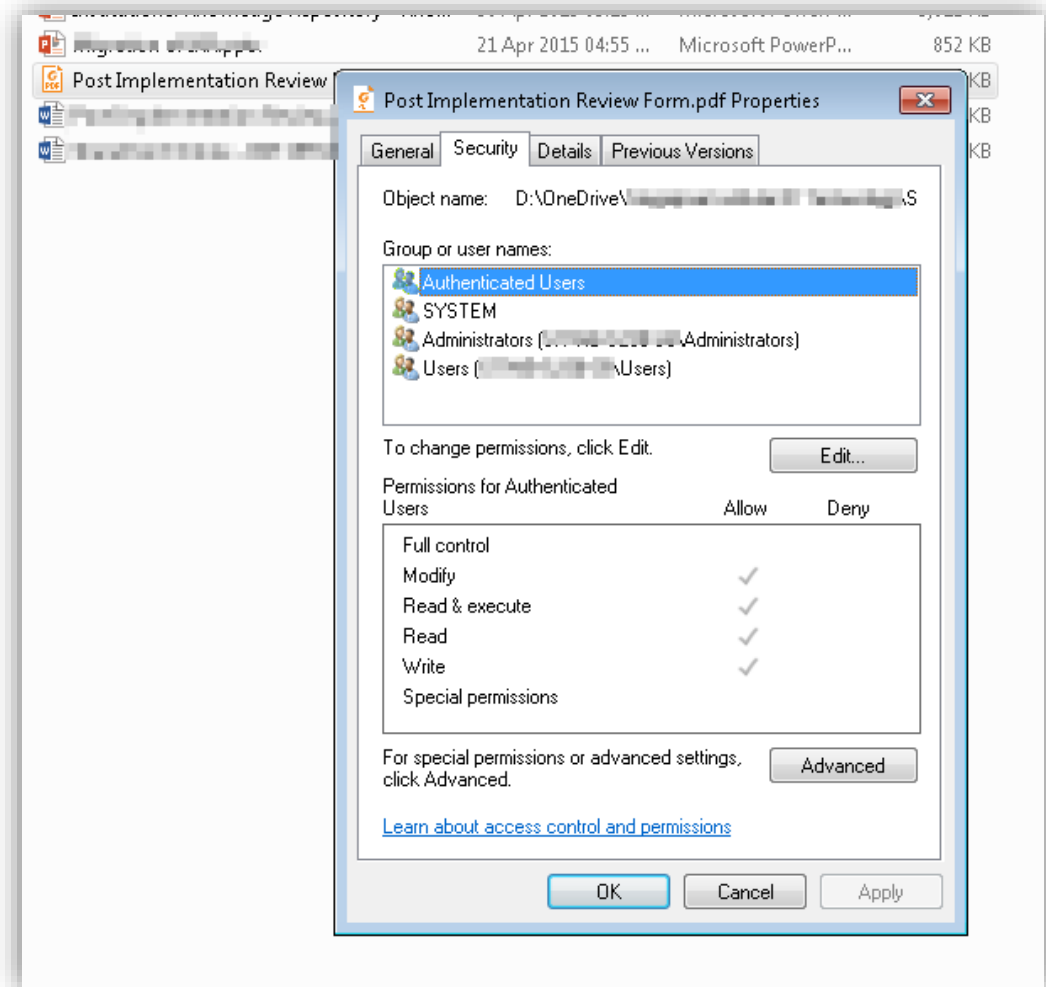

So now after sync stopped, the **Write** permission changed back to **Allow** (inherited).

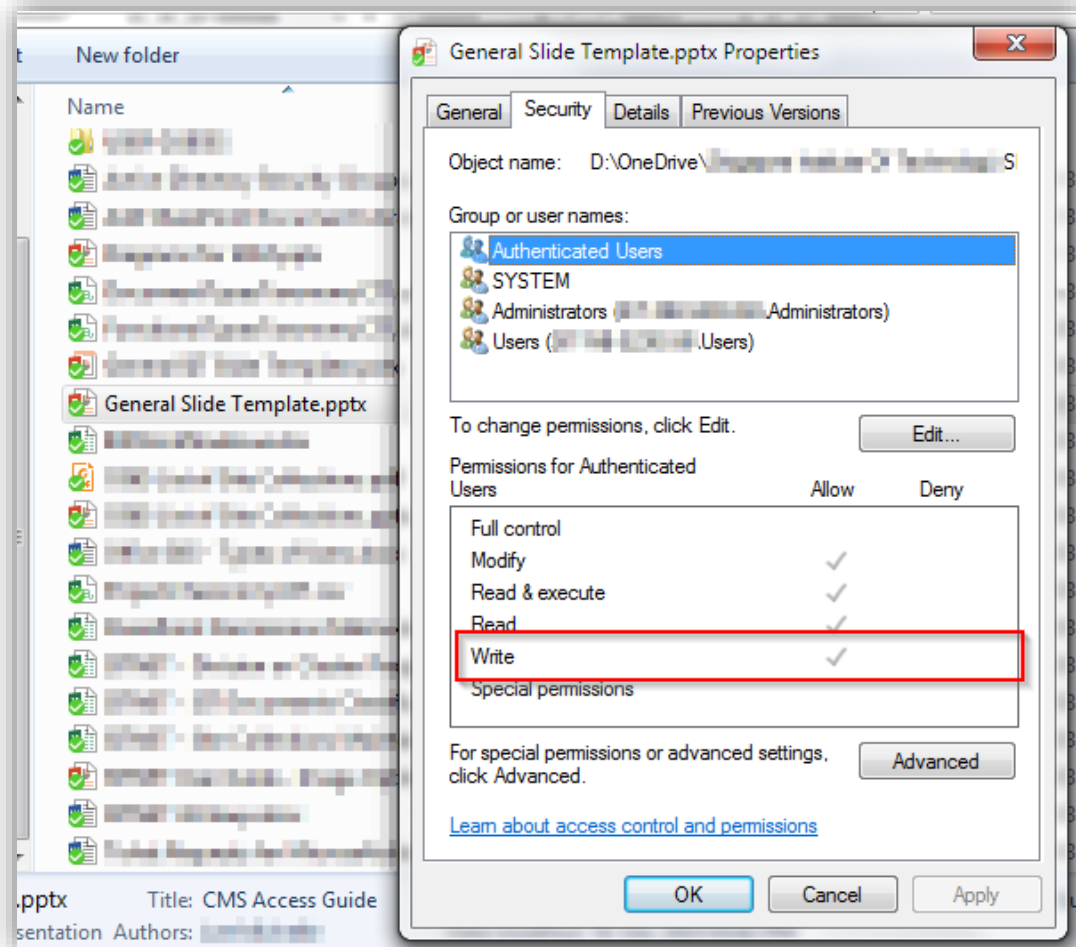

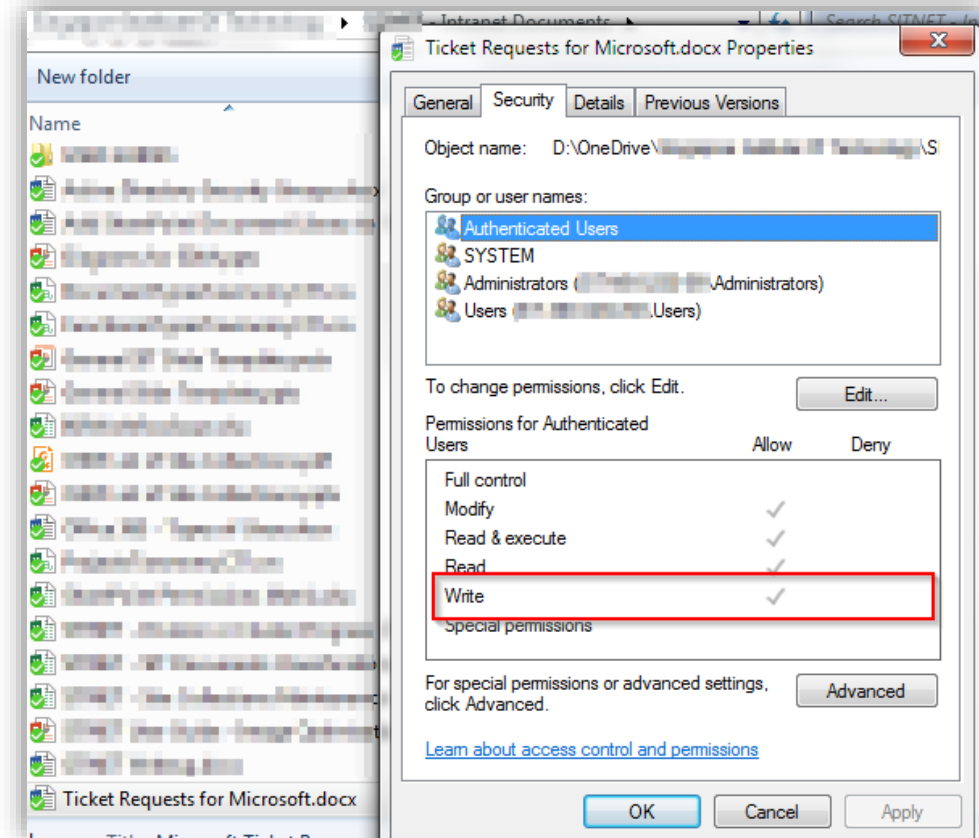

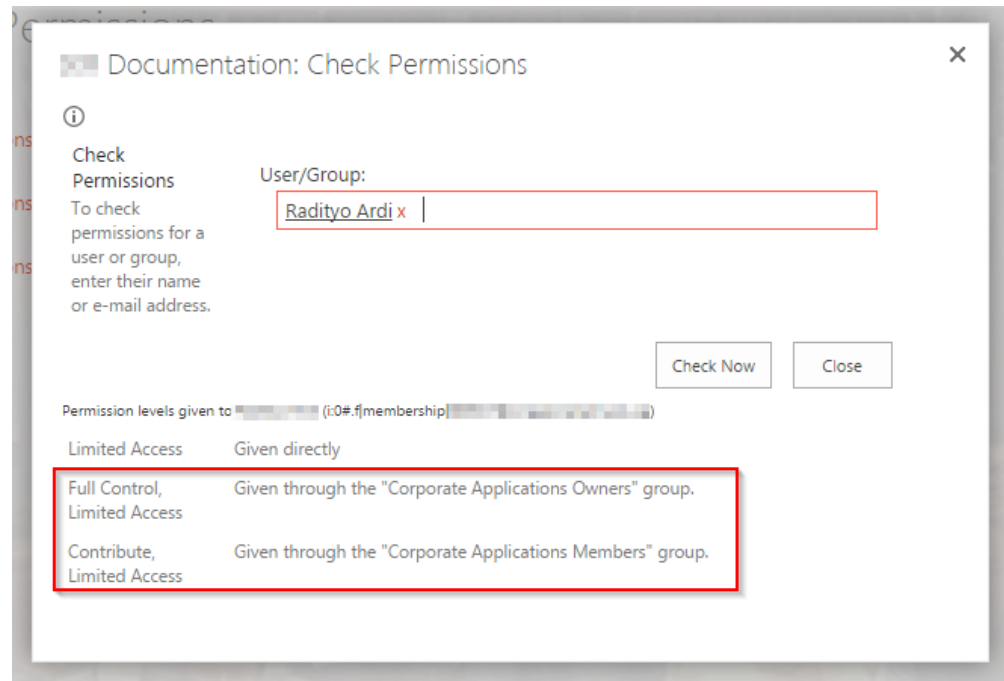
