

To whom it may concern:

I have been trying to use the Adobe Reader App on a Google Chromebook to read and fill out various PDF forms and documents; however, I have been struggling to work with the view setting options in the application.

When in continuous pages mode, the document cannot be zoomed out beyond a fit to width, which is often too tight a field of view to be able to see enough of the material.

If I change to Page-by-Page mode I can obtain a wider field of view but must zoom in to read the text. However, as I scroll to the next page the magnification will automatically revert to fitting the full page again and require me to zoom back at each page change.

My request is on the Chrome OS version of Reader, to allow the user in continuous page mode to zoom out beyond a fit to width and/or to allow the ability to retain your magnification setting in page-by-page mode as is similar to the behavior of the Acrobat program on a desktop computer.

Thank you for your consideration, and I would very much appreciate a response in regards to this option.
