

Participants Guide: HNSA Main Conference Program

On Demand Viewing Post Conference

The HNSA 2021 virtual conference was conducted via an online ticketing platform hosted by Regfox. This enabled an attendee to access a dashboard listing conference sessions with direct links to Zoom rooms in which speakers were featured.

If you have purchased post conference tickets, you'll be able to access the dashboard for the Weekend Two, 22-24 October Main Conference Program where all sessions you've purchased will be conveniently listed. You can view these on demand for 3 months ending at midnight on 1 February 2022.

Accessing the Conference Program and Workshops

To access your dashboard, find the confirmation email you received when you purchased your tickets. You can search for this email in your inbox by searching 'Regfox' or 'Registration Confirmation'. If you can't find your confirmation email, contact bookings@hnsa.org.au

Open the email and press the Access Virtual Event button in the email.



It will open your Regfox dashboard, which should look like this:

Watching your session



Elisabeth Storrs In Conversation With Geraldine Brooks


