

a. Drag Racing

i. Dragstrip Registration Rules & Regulations

- All vehicles must be **street legal** with valid license plates and registration. No paper or dealer license plates.
- All vehicles must be insured, with proof of insurance matching the vehicle's VIN number.
- All vehicles must pass safety and technical inspection.
- All drivers must be the registered owner of the vehicle.
- All drivers must be 21 years or older with a valid driver's license.
- Drivers must provide their own fuel.
- **DOT-approved tires only** (front and rear). No slicks. Rear tires must not protrude beyond the top of the fender.
- No passengers allowed in the vehicle once the event begins.
- No rental cars permitted.
- Long pants, closed-toe shoes, and/or SFI-rated safety gear required.
- **Driver + ONE crew member maximum** per vehicle.

Vehicle Inspection (upon arrival)

- · Battery must be secured.
- Fuel cell must be mounted and vented.
- No visible leaks.
- Coolant catch can required.
- Mufflers required (turbochargers count as mufflers).
- Functioning seatbelt and/or SFI harness required.



- No loose items inside the vehicle.
- Participants must review and sign a liability release/waiver.
- SA or M 2015 or 2020 Snell-rated helmet required. Helmet tag must be shown at tech. NO EXCEPTIONS.
- All drivers must pass a breathalyzer test.
- Rule compliance is at the discretion of the race director and event officials.

ii. Format

a. Racing Classes

• Small Tire Class:

- o Non "W" 28x10.5x15 or smaller DOT drag radial or bias DOT tires accepted.
- o Any 275/60/15 or smaller DOT drag radial accepted.
- OEM DOT treaded street tires with tread wear >200 accepted.
- o DOT-approved tires required front and rear.

Big Tire Class:

- o Tire size is **unlimited**, but must be DOT-approved front and rear.
- Safety gear for speed and ET is required.

b. Test Session & Qualifying

- Open test session allows multiple test runs.
- Timing system captures ETs and populates a qualifying program to determine the Top 8 for each class.
- Track opens for runs at **11:00 AM**.

c. Eliminations



- At ~5:30 PM, staging lanes are **closed** for test and tune.
- At 6:30 PM, the Top 8 qualifiers per class are announced and begin head-to-head eliminations.
- Chip draw determines race pairings for each elimination round.

iii. Tech Inspection

- Takes place Friday, August 8th, Specific details to be announced soon.
- Participants will receive a tech card, then await inspection.
- Once passed, racers receive **credentials and final registration**.
- No trailers permitted at tech on Friday.

iv. Registration

- Follow the tech inspector's directions to registration.
- You and your crew member must both be present to sign the waiver.
- You'll receive a wristband and vehicle credential.
- One crew member only per driver. No exceptions.
- After tech and registration, please **exit the area** to free space for others.

v. Parking

- Gates open at 7:30 AM on Saturday. Do not arrive earlier—no staging area available.
- Ensure your **vehicle decal is displayed** and both driver and crew wear wristbands.
- No trailers of any size allowed in the pit area.



- Bring all gear **inside your car**—no pop-ups, grills, or extra equipment permitted.
- Parking assignments are final; arrive with friends if you wish to park together.

vi. Drivers Meeting

- Mandatory meeting at 10:30 AM Saturday at the drag strip starting line.
- Attendance is required. **No show = no racing.**

vii. Staging

- Remain in your assigned pit stall until staff call you to staging lanes.
- **Do not enter** staging lanes early or you'll be disqualified and asked to leave.
- If skipped, report to the **Race Director**—do not enter the lanes without authorization.

viii. Racing Procedure

- Follow all Roadkill staff instructions at all times.
- Any **safety violations** or failure to follow direction = disqualification.
- After your run, return to your assigned pit stall.

ix. Post-Event

- Drag racing ends around 8:00 PM Saturday.
- Vehicles must be removed by **10:00 PM**, or they may be towed.
