Frequently Asked Questions (FAQs)

GENERAL

What is the CanVECTOR/Thrombosis Canada Conference?

The CanVECTOR/Thrombosis Canada 2026 conference is a two-day event focusing on venous thromboembolism (VTE). The first day, organized by CanVECTOR, centers on VTE research, whether in a laboratory or a clinical trial, to inform advances in clinical practice. The second day, led by Thrombosis Canada, tackles clinical challenges in thrombosis care, featuring expert insights and interactive sessions on a diverse range of topics.

When and where is the conference being held?

CanVECTOR/Thrombosis Canada 2026 conference takes place on Friday, November 6 and Saturday November 7, 2026, at the Doubletree by Hilton, Montreal, 1255 Jeanne-Mance Street, P.O. Box 130 Montreal, QC, H5B 1E5. Pre-conference meetings and a welcome reception will be held on November 5.

Is there a hybrid/digital component to the CanVECTOR/Thrombosis Canada conferences?

No, the conference is in-person only. Limited sessions from the Thrombosis Canada program will be recorded and made available after the event as part of the e-learning platform.

Is CanVECTOR/Thrombosis Canada 2026 accredited? How do I obtain CME credits?

We are planning to have the Thrombosis Canada program accredited. More information will be available once approved.

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REGISTRATION

When and how do I register?

Registration for CanVECTOR/Thrombosis Canada 2026 is online through our websites and with this link: <https://thrombosiscanada.regfox.com/2026-canvector-thrombosis-canada-conference>. Registration opens in May.

What are my options for registration for CanVECTOR/Thrombosis Canada 2026?

This year there will be three stages of registration: 2026 Early Bird Pricing until 11:59 June 30, 2026 after which Regular Registration will be open, and Onsite registration.

When is the last day to register for CanVECTOR/Thrombosis Canada 2026?

You may register for CanVECTOR/Thrombosis Canada 2026 online at any time. Registration is via the CanVECTOR/Thrombosis Canada 2026 websites and will remain available up and throughout the event.

What documents do I need to register and check in on site?

To register online, you will need to have your credit card information. If you are a member of CanVECTOR or Thrombosis Canada and/or have a special code for registration, you will be required to enter it as you register. If you are a student, you will be required to provide proof of student status from your institution or a letter from your supervisor prior to the conference.

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What is a trainee?

A trainee is a specialty or sub-specialty resident or fellow (those recognized by the Royal College) or a research trainee in a masters, doctoral, or post-doctoral program. Please note that trainee/student status will be verified prior to the conference.

I am an international delegate. Can I attend and can I request a visa letter of invitation?

International delegates are welcome to register and attend CanVECTOR/Thrombosis Canada 2026. A confirmation email will be sent upon registration, containing event details such as the event name, dates, and registrant's name. **Visa invitation letters are not provided.**

Why did the registration system reject my credit card information?

Your credit card may be rejected if the address verification you are entering is NOT your billing address. The address must match exactly what is printed on your credit card statement. It might be rejected if you have made more than five transactions within a 24-hour period. You are NOT registered if your credit card was not accepted. If you leave the site, your information is not saved. Some banks may block certain types of online purchases for security reasons. Should your transaction decline after several attempts, it is recommended to contact your bank immediately as they should be able to unblock it. I am an international delegate and my credit card was rejected upon registration. What do I do?

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Since you will be paying a Canadian institution, please call your bank or credit card company BEFORE you register and verify that you are authorized to make this payment online. You are NOT registered if your credit card was not accepted. If you leave the site, your information is not saved.

I registered and now need to alter my registration. How do I do this?

I registered but I can no longer attend. What is the refund policy/process?

Requests for refunds for registration cancellations will be subject to a \$50 administration fee (plus tax) and must be sent in writing to info@thrombosiscanada.ca and received by September 30, 2026. After September 30, no refunds will be offered.

HOUSING

How do I book my hotel room for the preferred rate?

During the registration process, you will be able to select and book your hotel room with the DoubleTree Hotel. After making your hotel reservation, you will receive a confirmation along with your registration confirmation that will show the hotel and dates that you have booked.
