

LEADERSHIP MERIT

Leadership Merits are a key training tool for all Royal Rangers age groups. Each Leadership Merit includes lessons on the following universal skills: Social Skills, Equipping Skills, Attitude Skills, Leadership Skills, and Servant Skills. This training is open to all boys in 3rd – 8th grade regardless of their involvement in an outpost. Leadership Merits are an excellent way to introduce and develop leadership skills.

Leadership Merits are intended to be taught every six months at the local outpost level either during weekly meetings or in a one-day format.

We recognize that outposts are unable to facilitate the Leadership Merits due to their small size or other reasons. For this reason, the Louisiana Royal Rangers has decided to trial the Leadership Merit 202 while the Ranger Kids Field Day is in progress. This allows outposts to travel to one location (Twin Lakes Campground), for two separate events. This gives outposts the opportunity to have an outing for most of their boys.

Leadership Merits require several hours of instruction, games, and activities. Boys will be required to arrive by 7:30AM. Dismissal will be at 3:30PM.
