GENERAL CONTEST INFO:

- **AAU DANCE RULES:** The 2026 AAU Baton Twirling Rulebook and the 2026 Dance Rulebook are available at www.aubaton.org with submission of entry forms. AAU Membership must be obtained **PRIOR** to submitting entry but is not required for open events (**NOTE AGES 18+:** Membership is not instant so please allow several days to process).
- **FACILITY FEE:** There will be a one-time \$20 facility fee per athlete. There is no door fee for spectators; the facility fee will be in place of a door fee.
All solo and team participants must pay this fee with their solo or team entry form.
- **PAYMENT:** Payment must be made when registering through the Red-Podium link.
NO PAPER ENTRIES!!
- **REFUNDS:**
**No refunds on entry fees or credits to other competitions will be given.
- **CHANGES TO ENTRIES:** The contest director reserves the right to make any changes deemed necessary. No changes by contestants may be made once an entry is received. ONLY errors made by the contest director will be corrected the day of the contest.
NO ENTRIES WILL BE ACCEPTED THE DAY OF THE CONTEST.
- **FOOD:** A concession stand will be provided during the day. Outside food or drinks are allowed, but not in the gym.
- **MUSIC:** All team and solo events that require music must email the music director an **MP3 file** to: kemericaau@gmail.com by the **March 19** entry deadline. Music will be played on a laptop through the sound system at the contest. Team directors and Solo Dancers should also bring two forms of back-up copies for your music (i.e. iPod, CD) to the contest.

- **WAIVERS:** Waivers must be signed & submitted with entry form for every participant in the competition (solo and team members). Participants will not be allowed to participate unless the necessary forms have been properly completed and signed by a parent/legal guardian or participant.

- Participants who are **AAU Members**
 - Eligible to win the Academic All-American Award and a scholarship.
 - Eligible to qualify to participate in the 2026 Junior Olympic Games.

- AAU Membership must be obtained **BEFORE** competition day in order to receive member benefits and qualifications.

FLORIDA DANCE TEAM EVENTS

AGE DIVISIONS: 0-5 (Kinder), 6-8 (Youth), 9-11 (Juvenile), 12-14 (Junior), 15-18 (Senior), Collegiate

CONTEST AGE: AGE AS OF 7/31/2026

TEAM SIZES (All Teams Except Production):
Extra-Small (2-3), Small (4-9), Large (10-19), Extra-Large (20+)

PRODUCTION TEAM SIZE: 10+

LEVELS: Recreational (no more than 1 ½ hrs in studio per week), Competitive/School Team (more than 1 ½ hrs in studio per week)

COST: \$15.00 per person, per routine

AWARDS: Each team member receives an award; results posted; directors pick up team awards at the end of teams.

TIME LIMITS: 1 ½-3 min (all teams except production); 6-8 min (production)

DANCE RULES: Will follow 2026 AAU Dance Rules.

DANCE TEAM EVENTS:

Pom, Jazz, Lyrical, Modern/Contemporary, Hip Hop, Kick, Musical Theater/Character, Novelty, Ballet, Production

FLORIDA SOLO DANCE EVENTS

Dancers wishing to do a solo, must enter the Solo Category corresponding to the type of solo they are performing (Jazz, Lyrical, Hip Hop, Modern/Contemporary, Pom).

Cost: \$30.00 per Dance Solo.

Contest Age: Age as of 7/31/2026

Age Divisions: 0-6, 7-9, 10-12, 13-15, 16-18, 19-22

Time Limit: 1 ½ min to 2 ½ mins maximum

ASSUMPTION OF RISK / WAIVER OF LIABILITY / INDEMNIFICATION AGREEMENT:

In consideration of being allowed to participate on behalf of the 2026 AAU Florida Baton & Dance Championship event, the undersigned acknowledges, appreciates and agrees that...

1. Participation includes possible exposure to and illness from infectious diseases, including but not limited to MRSA, influenza, and the novel COVID-19 virus. While particular discipline and practices implemented may reduce this risk of infection, the risk of serious illness and death does exist.
