First Aid Volunteer Job Overview

IN CASE OF AN EMERGENCY CALL 911

Thank you for all your support and volunteering for OFOAM!!! You are greatly appreciated, and we couldn't do it without you!! Below are a few tips/reminders to help your shifts go smooth 😊

Medical

- Provide basic first aid only for minor cuts, scrapes, burns, sun burns, insect bites, and dehydration
- **Call 911 for all medical emergencies**
- Provide privacy for any first aid services provided
- Fill out injury/treatment log for any first aid you provide
- Follow Weber/Morgan Health Dept Mass Gathering Permit guidelines
- Provide hand sanitizer and sunscreen as needed
- Keep fresh drinking water available at all times with cups and trash receptacle near by
 - Fill water jugs with white food grade hose only at spigot
 - Keep food grade hose off the ground
 - Use alcohol to clean spout of water coolers every hour at minimum and as needed (if spout comes in contact with refill containers)
 - Water jugs located
- Clean the nozzles of the multi-spigot water dispenser at least hourly

General

- Listen for any medical issues over radio
- Contact security on the radio as needed
- Contact site leader on the radio as needed
- NO DOGS allowed within festival gates, except service dogs who must be on a leash and picked up after. Dogs are allowed in the campground.
- Lost and Found
- Display Concert LineUp
- Merch product in trailer to secure for the night
- Lock up trailer for night (key in lock box in tongue)
