

## Ogden Music Festival 2026

### A.D.A. Parking Guide Job Overview

*Thank you for volunteering to be an Ogden Music Festival Volunteer! This guide will provide a simple outline of your role, responsibilities, and resources.*

**LEAD:** Tyson Pendleton (801)710-3448

**Role:** This volunteer position is dedicated to assisting elderly and disabled patrons with parking in the ADA-designated parking lot. Volunteers will provide courteous and patient support by directing vehicles to appropriate spaces. This role requires a compassionate attitude, attention to detail, and a willingness to create a welcoming and accessible environment for all guests.

#### **Duties:**

- **Greet all vehicles, direct traffic, and check for ADA placards/parking credentials.**

#### **Arriving Traffic Control:**

- Direct festvarians with South Campground Camping passes to the next volunteer station (Pro Shop), where they will take a left turn at the Pro Shop, and continue along the dirt road into the campground. Camp Guide volunteers will be available to assist them. Direct festvarians with ADA passes, or Oversized RV passes, into the parking lot (opposite the Visitor Center) through the South Access.

#### **Parking:**

- Festvarians with ADA placards/parking credentials will be directed to enter the South side of the ADA parking lot (opposite the Visitor Center), and guided to park their vehicles in the West and middle sections of that lot. The East side of this lot will be reserved for Oversized Camping RVs, which will have particular parking credentials and will need to be parked accordingly, diagonally from North to South.

#### **Exit Traffic Control:**

- As festvarians exit the park, volunteers will guide them through the exit located in the Northeast corner of the parking lot. They will turn right and follow the road back to the Shredder Bridge.

**Smile - be courteous but firm in directing festvarians to their parking spot. Keep a watchful eye and report any suspicious behavior to your team lead (Tyson) or security nearby.**

## ADA GUIDELINES



### ADA Parking

ADA parking is available in the visitor's center parking lot. Any vehicle with an ADA placard (see examples to the side) may park in the visitor's center lot. If an attendee needs assistance and does not have an ADA placard, please direct them to the ticket booth for a parking pass.

### Accessibility

Golf carts are available to transport guests. Please ask a team lead or site leader for assistance with contacting someone with a golf cart over the two-way radio to direct the golf cart to the guest.

### ADA Parking

ADA parking is available in the visitor's center parking lot. Any vehicle with an ADA placard (see examples to the side) may park in the visitor's center lot. If an attendee needs assistance and does not have an ADA placard, please direct them to the ticket booth for a parking pass.

### Accessibility

Golf carts are available to transport guests with ADA needs. Please ask a team lead or site leader for assistance with contacting someone with a golf cart over the two-way radio to direct the golf cart to the guest.
