

Ogden Music Festival 2026 Parking Crew Job Overview

We are grateful you're here to assist with parking for attendee convenience and safety!

Role: Work as a team to safely direct traffic in the upper parking lot to ensure maximum number of vehicles will fit, answer general questions and direct attendees to the ticket booth and festival venue. Your shift will be 3 hrs.,

The Upper Parking Lot will be set up ahead of the festival and feature:

- Separate motorcycle parking
- Some ADA parking - main ADA parking area is in the lot by the Visitor Center
- A cart to shuttle guests

Check in:

- When you arrive at Volunteer HQ before the start of your shift, you'll receive your safety vest. Parking lot crew must wear their safety vest.
- Lighted signaling wands are available if needed, please ask the team lead if you need one. Take the walkway to Upper Parking and look for the volunteer with a radio.

Need to bring: Sunscreen, mosquito repellent, sun shirt, shoes or boots that are comfortable for standing and walking on uneven terrain and to avoid junegrass, water bottle or personal water reservoir, small flashlight

Duties:

When you arrive on shift, familiarize yourself with the parking lot, available spots, and learn about the current situation from volunteers ending their shifts. Refer to the festival program and rules to answer most questions

Please help arriving guests remember the following:

- Leave coolers, glass, and alcohol in their vehicles
- Filled containers must be consumed before entering the venue
- Advise pet owners that pets are not allowed in the festival
- Leave shade structures in vehicles, shade will be provided

Direct attendees to the path to the festival and assist attendees who need assistance by calling on the radio for a golf cart ride.

Always have 3 people working together, never leave a volunteer alone. There can be some sketchy clientele walking through the area.

Please remember to return your vest to Volunteer HQ at the end of your shift, and when you are done with your volunteer commitment, get your Festival swag from Volunteer HQ and - *ENJOY!*

ADA GUIDELINES



ADA Parking
