

## Ogden Music Festival 2026 Kid Zone Job Overview

**Role:** Make each child feel welcome. Each child is able to make their own instrument to take home. We choose a different instrument for each festival, so it keeps it interesting for returning kids. We generally provide an almost completed instrument, and additional art supplies or materials to complete. You will be assisting with this project, helping the youngest ones, especially. **Please watch for each participant who should take only one instrument; we don't want to run out before the festival is over.** If we have extras on the last day, we can distribute leftovers. There are several other tables in the Kids Zone. Face painting is always popular, and if you feel you have any skills in this area, you will always be appreciated. Some volunteers are surprised they can do such a nice job with face paint, with no previous experience. Another table is dedicated to beading, and another to smaller children's craft activities.

*New this year... adaptive yoga for kids and adults, along with an obstacle foot course for kids, will take place both Saturday and Sunday mornings and will be completed by 11 AM, under the direction of GOAL and Ogden Adaptive Sports.*

### Duties:

- **Shift Starts:**
  - Ensure all craft tables have separated materials and are orderly
  - Please stay at the Kids Zone; the instrument Petting Zoo is separate and have their own volunteers.
  - Start and end times:
    - Friday 4:30 to 7:00 pm
    - Saturday 11:00 to 6:00 pm
    - Sunday 11:00 to 5:00 pm
  
- **Continuous:**
  - Clean as you go, especially the ground.
  - Replace tablecloths when needed, tape each corner - the wind will blow these off easily unless taped well.
  - Wash all paint brushes and shift
  - Encourage participants and parents to assist in cleaning and tidying
  - Assist the smallest children with anything needed

- **Saturday Afternoon:**
  - Inform parents and children of the upcoming stage performance
  - Round up the kids!
  - Practice song with the band
  - Lead children to the stage for performance.
  
- **Sunday Afternoon:**
  - Begin end clean up, consolidate all supplies
  - Clean tables
  - Pack items into boxes and bins
  - Make sure there are no beads or small items on the ground, leave no trace.
  - Take garbage bags to the dumpsters if possible.

Each night, Kids Zone supplies will be moved into the large GOAL trailer along with the instruments from the Instrument Petting Zoo. Please coordinate times and be sure it gets locked.

Please be mindful of the area and materials and help where needed without being asked. Please do not work on your own projects or face paint while on shift.

Please stay in the kids' zone on shift and ask for breaks as necessary.
