

Annual Moonlight Hayride & Bonfire Event at Blake's FAQ's

NOTE: Parents/Guardians/Scouts bring flashlights to help combat darkness and lack of visibility for the surrounding area.

Q. What is the purpose of this event?

A. The spirit of this event is to kick-off the new Girl Scout year for Girl Scouts and their adult chaperones. Make new friends and meet-up with old friends!

Renew your daughter's GSUSA Membership and come out to Blake's for our celebration and save \$\$\$ with a discounted entry fee!

Q. Can I bring my entire family?

A. Yes! This at the discretion of the adult. See the purpose statement above.

Q. Is it OK to bring my baby/toddler?

A. Yes! This is at the discretion of the adult. See the purpose of this event above.

Q. Which Blake's location is this event held at?

A. Blake's Orchard & Cider Mill located at 17985 Armada Center Road, Armada, MI 48005.

Q. Is Blake's Funland open to the public during this event?

A. Yes!

Q. What form of payment does Blake's take?

A. Tickets are to be purchased online using the Ticket Spice system 24 hours in advance. There will be a service fee associated with the ticket purchase.

- *Online tickets are delivered digitally via email. Tickets can then be printed at home or displayed on your phone when you arrive.*
- *All ticket sales are final- there are no refunds.*

Upon check-in, each person in your group will receive a ticket voucher to exchange for their cup of cider and a donut.

Q. Why do I need to pre-purchase a ticket?

A. This will help Blake's with staffing purposes, donut & cider supplies.

Q. What is included in the fee?

A. A cup of cider, a donut, unlimited hayrides, bonfire; plus, admission to Funland!

Funland Activities: Giant Jumping Pillows, Animal Petting Farm, Corn Maze, Straw Mountain, Tricycle

Track & John Deere Pedal Carts, Sports Zone, Inflatable Axe Throwing, Blake's Haunted House/Village and MORE!

Q. Do adults have to pay?

A. Yes.

Q. Will this event be cancelled due to weather conditions?

A. No, this event will be held rain, snow, wind or shine. Dress for the weather.

Blake's may close for extreme conditions/government mandate; refunds will be automatically issued via the Ticket Spice system.

Q. Is there a fun patch available?

A. Yes, fun patches are available for pre-purchase. The cost is \$4.65 (\$3.50 + \$1.15 fee)

Q. Do we have to participate in the Service Project?

A. No, this is an option for girls to provide service to others as a troop or individually.

Q. Can I bring in outside food, pets, can I smoke, consume alcohol?

A. NO, NO, NO, NO.

REMINDER: During this function, tobacco use, consumption of alcohol or use of illegal drugs in the

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presence of girl members is never allowed as written in the Safety Activity Checkpoints.

Q. Is there food to purchase?

A. Yes. Blake's Cider Mill is open and sells donuts, cider, sweet treats, fresh produce, canned goods & snacks along with the Tasting Room and Orchard Square Tap options.

Q. Where should I park?

A. Parking is available across the street. Expect the parking lot next to Funland to be congested upon arrival. Plan accordingly.

Q. Where is the line for the unlimited hayrides?

A. Boarding the hayrides can be accessed outside of the Barnyard Funland area to your left when facing the Barnyard Funland entrance/registers.

Q. What is the approximate event timeline?

- 6 pm: Check-in begins; receive cider/donut ticket
- 6 – 9: pm: Enjoy Funland activities; unlimited hayride; cider & donut distribution; exchange your ticket for a glass of cider & one donut
- 7 pm: Volunteer led sing-a-long around bonfires
- 8 pm: Hayrides will end.
- 8:15pm: Donut and Cider Distribution will end
- 9 pm: Cider Mill store will close.
- 9 pm: Thank you, see you next year!
