Vendors must supply their own tents, tables, chairs, etc. You may set up your booth in any way that does not overflow your designated area or interfere with safe pedestrian movement. Power is available to all booth spaces. You will need to provide your own extension cord.

No vehicles or trailers will be permitted on the festival grounds or at vendor booths once the festival begins. All vehicles must be parked in their designated parking area at least 30 minutes before the start of the festival. Vehicles cannot be on the festival grounds at any time during festival operations (due to insurance regulations).

Your application and fee must be turned in and cleared before September 15th.

The Festival committee reserves the right to fill spaces not confirmed on opening day, with all fees forfeited by the vendor.

Vendors are expected to keep their area clean, with trash picked up regularly and boxes, etc. deposited in the garbage bin at the close of the festival.

In the event a dispute shall arise between the parties to this contract, the parties agree to participate in a meeting before the full Festival Board for resolution.

Local and State Laws regarding Business Licensing. Food Vendors are required to have a SC Retail License number. This can be obtained online at the SC Department of Revenue.

Also, Commercial vendors need to provide proof of the following certificates:

INSURANCE

General Liability Insurance of no less than \$1,000,000 per occurrence and \$2,000,000 aggregate is required by the Licensee. The policy shall name The FARM Center and Oconee County, its agents, and/or employees as Additional Insured. The policy must also name The FARM Center as the Certificate Holder. A Certificate of Insurance (COI) must be submitted to our office within 10 days before the festival.

Workers' Compensation insurance for all employees and volunteers as required by state law and policy information must be shown on the COI.

INDEMNIFICATION

The Licensee shall indemnify, defend, and hold harmless The FARM Center and its respective officers, directors, employees, agents, and representatives, from and against any and all third-party claims, demands, actions, causes of action, fines, losses, or damages whatsoever, as well as any related costs and expenses, including reasonable attorney fees, arising out of their activities and/or any breach of this Agreement.
