

2026 USAF SUMMER CAMP INFORMATION (as of 7/21/2026)

Camp Information:

Day fees: You may purchase day fees on the day of attendance, however, please register in advance online, as NO CASH OR CHECKS WILL BE ACCEPTED FOR DAY PASSES. CREDIT CARDS ONLY, please.

Camp T-shirts: Camp t-shirts will be for sale. Again, NO CASH OR CHECKS WILL BE ACCEPTED FOR T-SHIRT PURCHASES. CREDIT CARDS ONLY, please.

Dojo and Changing rooms: Classes will be held in the Bayview Ballroom (dojo). There are changing rooms available near the dojo for day people and people not staying on-site. Of course, if you are staying at the hotel, you are welcome to go to-and-from your room to the dojo in your dogi.

Weapons Classes. Weapons classes will be held under the pavilion to the right of the dojo, or directly in front on the veranda. There are a limited number of bokken and jo available to borrow at the dojo on a first-come, first-serve basis. To borrow a weapon, you will need to leave your camp ID (or other form of ID) at the registration desk prior to the weapons class. Please return all weapons as soon as class is over, at which point you will get back your ID.

Water. The camp will **not** be providing water bottles this year, so please make sure to bring your own. Several water coolers will be available at the dojo to help you stay hydrated.

Instructors meeting: An instructors meeting will be held in the dojo at noon on Wednesday, July 29th, at noon. This is open to anyone who teaches in a USAF dojo, not just chief instructors.

Song Circle: Joshua Layton of Montérégie Aikikai will be hosting the first-ever Camp Song Circle on Tuesday, July 28th at 8:00 PM, in the hotel (location TBA). Everyone is welcome to lead a song, sing along, play a tune, or simply listen. There's no requirement to be a musician. Lyrics for some accessible group songs will be provided, and there will be no pressure to perform.

Meals:

- **Breakfasts.** Breakfast is not included, but you will be able to purchase a buffet breakfast during camp at the hotel at the discounted rate for our group of \$19.99++ for adults, 6-12 year olds are half price and 0-5 year olds can eat breakfast for free. An a la carte menu is also available.
- **Lunches:** Lunch is not included, but If you wish to stay on site for your lunch, there will be a “Grab and Go” option (sandwiches, salads etc) available Monday, July 27th through Thursday, July 30th from 11:00 - 3:00pm at the Grill Room bar. The Grill Room will also be serving a lunch menu.
- **Dinners:** ID badges/dinner tickets will handed out at registration and are required to enter the dining room. The banquet on Thursday evening is a casual event, though some people enjoy dressing up.

Hotel Policies/Amenities: The hotel management has asked us to inform you of certain policies. Thank you in advance for helping us be accommodating and respectful of their policies.

- Personal grills cannot be used at the pool or anywhere on property.
- You may only consume food & beverages purchased at the hotel in any public area. Anything brought in from the outside must be consumed in your room.
 - A cash bar will be available at the banquet on Thursday night. You may purchase alcohol at the hotel bar and bring it to dinner on the other nights.
- Please do not hang your dogi or any laundry from your room windows or balconies
- **Laundry Service.** The hotel’s laundry service is available for \$14.00 per full uniform, or \$6 for dogi pants and \$10 for dogi jacket (oversized is \$12) plus \$6 per shirt. There is a limit, however, to how many uniforms the hotel can manage per day, so this is on a first-come first-serve basis. Please inquire at the front desk for further information. There are also laundromats within a short drive from the hotel.

- There is an indoor and outdoor pool, so bathing suits are advised! There is also a rec room on-site with a large screen TV, comfy couches, a pool table etc.
