

Dojo Etiquette

- 1 – Please bow to the kamiza each time you enter and leave the dojo , and line-up quietly before each class.
- 2 – If you are late for class, you may enter the dojo and bow onto the mat. You do not need to wait for the instructor's permission to join the class.
- 3- Cameras/phones are not allowed on the mat. If you wish to take photos/videos, please do the following:
 - 1 – ask the instructor of that class for permission
 - 2 – step off the mat when using your camera/phone
 - 3 – no photographing is permitted from the kamiza side of the mat
- 4 – Please hold your clapping until the end of the last (or only) class that the instructor is teaching during the week.
- 5 – Some chairs will be available in the dojo for sitting and watching class. Please do not sit or place personal belongs along the kamiza wall.
- 6 – The water and chair located near the fire exit door is only for the instructor's use.
- 7 – Please do not share or post photos/videos of anyone's test on social media without permission of the person (or people) in the photo or video
- 8 – Volunteering to help clean and take care of the mats in between classes and at the end of the day, and helping take them apart/load the truck at the end of camp is very much appreciated.
- 9 – Please do not ask people at the camp registration table to watch your bags or belongings.
- 10 – Pets are not allowed in the dojo/ballroom or the dojo/ballroom lobby, unless it is a service dog.
- 11 – When class begins and warm-ups or demonstrations are underway, please keep the noise volume at a minimum in the dojo/ballroom lobby.
- 12 – Please remember to take your personal items with you, as neither the USAF nor the Seaview Hotel are responsible for any items left in the dojo/ballroom or the dojo/ballroom lobby.
