The charter bus will leave from the Activity Center parking lot promptly at the listed departure time. Arrive 10+ minutes early to check-in with your travel escort and find your seat on the bus. You will not be permitted on the bus before the travel guide arrives. **IF YOU ARE LATE:** alert us immediately by calling/texting the number listed above. Otherwise, the bus will not wait and we will regrettably have to leave without you.

Bus seating is on a first come, first serve basis. Should you prefer to sit in the front, or prefer to sit with a friend, you may wish to arrive early and together with your group. The seats you choose will remain the same through the trips' entirety. The front seat (behind stairs) is reserved for the travel escort.

If you would like to keep belongings on the bus (coffee mugs, bags, etc.) the driver will lock the vehicle while we are away.

Food and beverages are permitted on the bus. However, beverages *must* be consumed in a closed-lid container. No glass.

Please use the restroom prior to arriving at the Activity Center. The bus restroom is for "emergency situations" only.

Please store your Travel Guide's number in your phone. Be sure to provide us with a LOCAL emergency contact, in case of an emergency or unforeseen problem.

If your bus trip experience was positive, please remember to tip your driver upon return to Citrus Hills.

Additional Game-Day Information:

ACCESSIBILITY: We want to emphasize that there is about a 1 block walk to the stadium gate from the bus drop off. Once at the gate, wheelchair assistance is available to and from our seats (if needed.) Please let your travel guide know *at time of registration* should you need support re: mobility.



TICKETS: Stadium tickets are now distributed digitally thru the free mobile app "BALLPARK" - no physical tickets will be printed per MLB. When downloading the app, ensure the logo matches the one to the left to ensure you're selecting the correct and certified app.

When you register for the game with the Activity Center, please provide a working and accurate email address, as this will be our main form of communication. **The email address you use registering with Citrus Hills with must be the same one that you use to log into your ballpark app.** The app is where your tickets will be stored, and is what you show to gate attendants at the stadium.

1-2 weeks prior to the game date, you should see your tickets reflected in your app. Even if you have already registered with the Activity Center and paid, you will not see them in your app until a few weeks prior to the game. GROUP SEATS: Our group seats are located in section 214, overlooking the first base line. If you desire stadium seats next to a friend (and you purchased tickets separately from them) please notify us as soon as possible. Note that seating requests are not guaranteed, however, we will do our very best to accommodate each inquiry. Please see below for a map.

HURRICANE REPAIRS: The stadium has undergone significant repairs and upgrades following Hurricane Milton in October 2024, so you can expect a refreshed interior for the 2026 season.

BAG POLICY: Tropicana Field has a clear bag policy. Fans may bring one (1) single-compartment clear bag (plastic, vinyl, or PVC) no larger than 12" x 12" x 6" and/or one (1) non-clear small fanny pack or clutch, no larger than 5" x 7". Backpacks, non-transparent bags, and oversized bags are not permitted at Tropicana Field. Exceptions will be made for diaper bags accompanying a young child and medical device bags.
