Your Group Leader is there to ensure a smooth and enjoyable experience for everyone. While every effort will be made to follow the planned itinerary, adjustments may be made at the Group Leader's discretion if necessary. Any decisions will be made with the best interest of the group as a whole in mind. We appreciate your understanding and cooperation as we work to provide a safe and well-organized trip experience.

Bus Information

Please do not board the bus prior to checking in with your Group Leader. Plan to arrive with enough time to check in and get settled. We recommend allowing at least 10 minutes prior to departure.

Kindly use the restroom at home before arriving. A restroom is available on the bus for emergency use if needed.

Seating on the bus is first come, first served. If you prefer to sit toward the front or with friends, you may wish to arrive early. Your selected seat will remain yours for the duration of the trip. Please note that the front seat directly behind the stairs is reserved for the Group Leader.

You are welcome to leave personal belongings on the bus, such as bags or small items. The driver will lock the vehicle while we are away.

If you have had a positive experience, gratuities for your driver are always appreciated at the conclusion of the trip.

If You Are Running Late

If you anticipate being late, you must notify your Group Leader immediately by calling or texting the number listed above. Please understand that the bus cannot be held for late arrivals, and we may have to depart without you.

What is included with my ticket?

Your ticket includes roundtrip transportation aboard a motor coach, services of a professional Group Leader or Travel Guide, admission to the Broadway-style performance, and an all-you-care-to-eat buffet dinner. Complimentary coffee, tea, and soft drinks are included. A full-service bar offering beer, wine, cocktails, and premium spirits is available for purchase throughout the evening.

What can I expect for dinner?

The theater offers a buffet featuring a variety of American-style favorites. Menu selections vary by performance and typically include vegetarian, non-dairy, and low-carbohydrate options, as well as a fish entrée. Guests with food allergies or significant dietary restrictions should notify the Activities Director or Travel Guide at the time of registration. While accommodations cannot be guaranteed, every effort will be made to assist with special dietary needs.

Is gratuity included?

Tax and gratuity for the dinner portion of your evening are already included in the ticket price. Should you purchase alcoholic beverages or other additional items, gratuity is not included. A suggested gratuity amount will be provided on your final tab, though tipping remains entirely at your discretion.

Is there a dress code?

The theater does not enforce a formal dress code. However, we recommend attire appropriate for an evening out. Most guests choose business-casual clothing, while others may dress more formally for special occasions. Beachwear, cut-off shorts, and overly casual attire are discouraged.

Accessibility Information

Guests should be able to navigate at least two stairs and walk independently without the use of a wheelchair or walker. If you use a cane or require ADA accommodations, please notify the Activities Director or Group Leader as soon as possible so that appropriate arrangements can be explored.

May I take photographs or videos?

Photography and video recording during the performance are strictly prohibited by law. Guests are welcome to take photos throughout the theater and at their tables before the show begins and during intermission, but no photography or video recording is permitted while performers are on stage. This restriction includes cell phones and other electronic devices.
