



Welcome to the Central Florida Scottish Highland Games

RV Dry Camping Area Regulations: Please read the entire document.

This year you will enter the park as follows.

From State Road 434 Turn at the traffic light for Tuskawilla Rd North by the McDonalds. Continue North to the end of the road. You must then turn left or West onto Orange Ave, for a quarter of a mile to the park. The Baseball Diamonds will be on your left. Take the first left inside the park. Keeping the Baseball Diamond on your left. Look for a yellow vested parking attendant or a RV parking sign by the gate to the park. A map will be sent to you with your Parking Tag via e-mail 10 days before the event. **Remember to print them in color.** To make parking and set-up easy and fun, please be mindful of the following rules:

- **Check-in is only Friday, January 16th between 10 am - 4 pm EST.**
- **ALL RV'S MUST BE SET-UP FOR: "self-contained dry camping"** meaning no connections or services will be provided.
- **City of Winter Springs Ordinance prohibits open fires in the park.**
- **NO SWIMMING IN LAKE JESUP! IT IS INFESTED WITH ALLIGATORS.**
- **GENERATORS:** may be used from **6 A.M. to 11 P.M. only**. City Ordinance forbids generator use during quiet hours. However, Medical ADA requirements will override.
- **RV LEVELING SYSTEMS RECOMMENDED:** Levelers should use pads for the safety of the unit and you, this is a park, and it is very likely your RV will be on soft dirt or grass.



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- **WARNING:** The park is located on the shores of Lake Jesup, home to the greatest population of Alligators in Central Florida. No swimming or wading, no moonlight strolls in the woods. No kidding.
- **RV PARKING is for Friday, Saturday, and Sunday nights.** All RVs must be out of the Camping area no later than noon on the following Monday.
- **NO TENT CAMPING:** The only exception will be the area reserved for the Boy Scouts, who are Games' Volunteers.
- **AREA SECURITY:** There will be Parking Volunteers on Friday and overnight security to assist you. You are encouraged to dial 911 in an emergency.
