Statement of Faith

- We believe that the Bible is the inspired, inerrant Word of God and accept that Scripture is the final authority in all matters of faith and practice which provides sufficient instruction for how we ought to live and what we should understand about God & mankind. (Isaiah 40:8; 2 Tim. 3:16-17; John 17:17)
- We believe in one God, eternally existing in three persons: Father, Son, and Holy Spirit, three in one—coequal, which is the Trinity. (Matt. 28:19; Gen. 1:1-2; John 1:1-4, 14; John 10:30; John 15:26)
- We believe that Jesus Christ is the one and only Son of God who died for our sins and arose from the dead. He alone is the hope of salvation for mankind. (1 Cor. 15:1-8; Acts 4:12; John 3:16-17; Hebrews 6:19-20)
- All have sinned and fall short of the glory of God, but we believe that the forgiveness of sins and promise of eternal life are available to those who accept Jesus Christ as Savior and Lord. (Rom. 3:23; John 3:16; Acts 2:21)
- We believe that to accept Christ one should repent of sin, confess faith in Christ, and be baptized into Him. (Rom. 10:9; Acts 2:38; John 3:5; Mark 16:16; Romans 6:3-4; Acts 3:19; John 6:47)
- We believe that God makes Himself known through the splendor of His creation, manifesting His eternal power and divine nature through the order and beauty of the universe. (Rom. 1:20; Ps. 19, 104)
- We believe that God wonderfully and immutably creates each person as either male or female, and that these two distinct, complementary sexes together reflect the image and nature of God. (Gen. 1:26-27)
- We believe that God created marriage to be exclusively the union of one man and one woman, and that intimate sexual activity is to occur exclusively within that union. (Gen. 2:18-25; 1 Cor. 6:18; 7:2-5; Heb. 13:4)
- We believe that all human life is sacred and created by God in His image. Human life is of inestimable worth in all its dimensions, including but not limited to pre-born babies, the aged, the physically or mentally challenged, and every other stage or condition from conception through natural death. We are therefore called to defend, protect, and value all human life. (Psalm 139)
- We believe that God invites each person, endowed with such great dignity, to encounter Him in His creation, in His word, and in holy relationships with one another. (1 John 4:7-21; Ps. 104; 2 Tim. 3:16)
- We believe that the Church is the unified body of Christ on earth, empowered by the Holy Spirit, which exists to equip the saints for the work of ministry to make disciples by speaking the truth in love. (Eph. 4:1-16; Matt. 28:19-20)
- We believe that Jesus Christ will one day return to earth to redeem His church. Christians will be joined with Him together in heaven forever. (1 Thess. 4:13-18)
