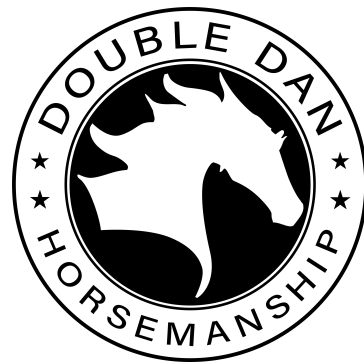


Double Dan Horsemanship Clinic Information



Welcome

Thank you for registering for a Double Dan Horsemanship Clinic with Dan James! In preparation for your time at the clinic, please review the following information and FAQs carefully. This document outlines the schedule, participant requirements, farm rules, and other important details to ensure a smooth and enjoyable experience.

General Schedule

What time does the clinic start?

Clinics begin at 9:00 AM each day. It is recommended to arrive 30 minutes early to park, get settled, and take in the surroundings. Dan will start with a brief introduction and organize the day's sessions.

How is the clinic structured?

Each participant works individually with Dan during a scheduled session. Sessions run from 9:00 AM to approximately 4:00 PM, with a one-hour lunch break around midday. The schedule will be determined on the first day of the clinic.

Can I bring my horse if I'm auditing?

No. Only clinic participants may bring horses. Auditor spots are for observation and learning only.

Do I need to bring a chair?

No. Chairs are provided for all attendees.

Is lunch provided?

A fully stocked coffee bar, light refreshments and water are provided, but no full meals. Please bring your own lunch and snacks. There will be a one-hour lunch break each day.

When will I get directions and other clinic info?

A Welcome Guide will be emailed a few days before the clinic. It includes:

- Directions to the farm

- Parking information
- Gate access code
- Check-in location
- Assigned stalls (if applicable)
- Daily schedule and what to bring

Participant Information

Can I ride or work my horse outside of clinic hours?

Yes, but only if:

- A waiver has been signed, and
- You have checked with Dan or the DDH crew to ensure the arena, round pen, or other areas are open and available.

What paperwork is required for my horse?

All horses must have:

- An up-to-date **Health Certificate**
- A current **Coggins**

These documents are required at check-in on the first day of the clinic. They can also be emailed ahead of time to info@doubledanhorsemanship.com. Please include the participant name and clinic as a reference.

How do I reserve a stall?

Stalls are available for **\$35 per day** and are **self-care** (bring your own buckets, feed, and tools). Shavings are available for purchase or you may bring your own.

A registration form will be sent closer to the clinic date to reserve stalls, RV hookups, and pay the clinic balance.

Are RV hookups available?

Yes. A limited number of RV hookups are available for **\$45 per night**, on a first-come, first-served basis. We have water and electric for the camping spots. Please bring any hookups you will need to connect. We have 30 and 50 amps. We do not have a shower house available on site.

Farm Rules

- **No dogs or other pets** are allowed on the property or during the clinic.
- **No hand grazing** on any grass or lawn areas.

- No fires are permitted on the property.
- Respect all property, equipment, and other participants.
- Follow all posted safety instructions and staff directions.

Arrival and Departure Guidelines

Earlie Arrival: No arrivals before 3:00 PM on the day before the clinic begins. Early arrivals beyond this will not be permitted.

Late Departure: All participants must depart by **9:00 AM** the day after the clinic ends. Staying past this time is not allowed.

Stall Care: Stalls are self-care. Participants are required to leave stalls clean and in the same condition as found. By registering for this clinic, participants agree to clean their stalls upon departure.

Cancellation Policy

Non-Refundable Cancellation Policy:

In the event that a participant needs to cancel their clinic registration, a 100% non-refundable fee will be applied. This fee is non-negotiable and helps maintain the quality and organization of the clinic.

Clinic fees may be credited but not refunded.

- Credited fees are transferable and can be applied toward another clinic or transferred to another person within one year from the clinic date.
- Credits expire after one year if not used toward another clinic.
