## Early Literacy Summer Program



A New Early Intervention Literacy Program  
with a Focus on Primary Students

Some children finish Kindergarten, Grade 1, or Grade 2 still feeling unsure about reading or writing. They may struggle with sounds, letters or printing. They may read slowly, guess at words, avoid writing, or become frustrated when spelling doesn't make sense. These early gaps are common, and students respond well when provided the right kind of expert intervention.

Our **Early Literacy Program** is a two-week, small-group intensive program designed to strengthen the core skills that underpin successful reading and writing in a safe, warm environment. The program runs Monday to Friday from 9:00–11:30 am for two weeks and is intentionally short, focused, and developmentally targeted for young learners new to Reach. Participation in this year's program is highly limited to ensure we can target specific intervention and change the trajectory these primary students are facing so they have a better opportunity to experience success with reading and writing.
