

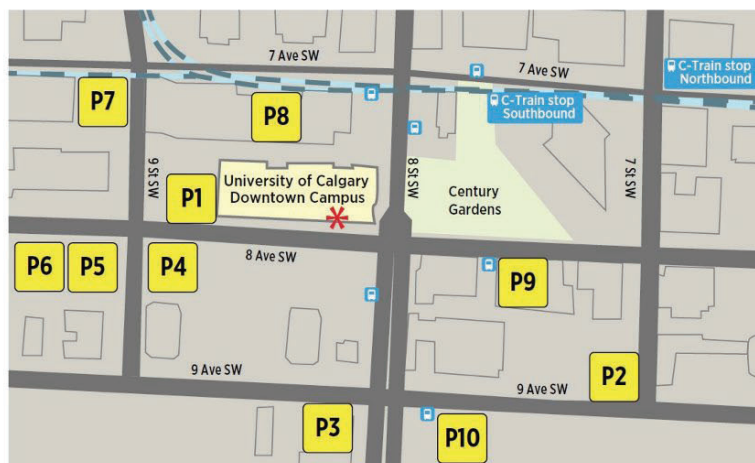


Parking/Transportation – Downtown Campus

Public Parking - There are several parking locations available around the Downtown Campus.

Indigo Lot 162 – this is the parkade attached to the downtown campus building. The entrance can be accessed directly from 8th Avenue SW.

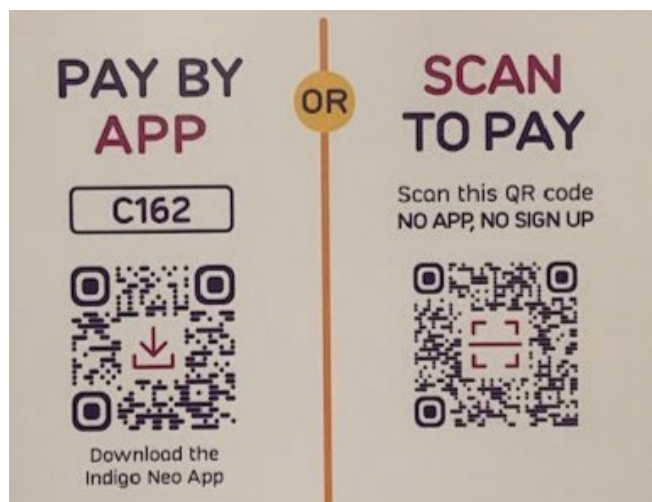

Directions for parking in attached parkade – Lot 162:

Pre-payment or on the spot payment can be processed by using the Indigo Neo cell phone application (app can be download from Google Play or App Store)

Scan the QR code on the left using your cell phone camera or open the Indigo Neo App on your cell phone.

Follow the prompts to select time needed and make a payment.

- **Important Note** - Your receipt should include a code which you will need to access the parkade and return to your vehicle following the event. Please ensure you know this code.
- If you are able to print the receipt and bring it with you, please do so. Otherwise, please email your receipt to downtown@ucalgary.ca where it will be printed and provided to the event organizer the day of the event.

After Parking – Access to the Downtown Campus

- From any floor of the parkade (Lot 162), head to the elevator (second set of doors, on the right).
- Take the elevator to the ground floor and walk straight out of the corridor to the sidewalk (8th Ave).
- Take a left and walk half a block to the outer entrance of the University of Calgary downtown campus.
- Enter through the doors and take elevator or stairs to the second floor, DTC 241 is on the left.

Getting Back to your Vehicle/Parkade

- You can access the parkade going back the same way you entered from; however, you will need the access code provided at the time of payment to unlock the parkade door. Please ensure you keep this code with you. You can also request a Safewalk escort back to your vehicle.

Safewalk

Please note – the downtown campus offers a SafeWalk program to anyone who works at or visits the Downtown Campus. Your safety is important to us. Property management Security Members will walk with anyone who works at or visits the Downtown Campus – students, staff, faculty, clients, visitors, and contractors.

How to Get a Walk

- Visit the Security desk at the 8th Avenue entrance (no booking required)
- Call 403.473.2614 (DTC security line)
- Talk to a member of DTC security
- Email dtsecure@ucalgary.ca to book a walk in advance
- Allow up to 15 min for your walk, depending on the location of the Security Member on duty.

Other Transportation Options

Calgary Transit - The Downtown Campus is located one block away from the 7th Street C-Train Station. For complete listing of bus and C-train stops, please visit the Calgary Transit website.

Bicycle/Scooter Parking - Please be advised that scooters, rollerblades and bikes are **prohibited** in the Downtown Campus building. Please use the bike cage provided.

Users can pay the day fee and obtain the code by checking in with the Security Desk on the main floor of the Downtown Campus. The fee is \$5.00 per day.

While we recommend using a lock in the bike cage, the bike cage itself has a reinforced locking mechanism and the parkade is secured, with the exception of when vehicles enter/exit.
