For GPS, the camp road will be marked either as Encino Ranch Road or Cooley Lane depending on the app you use.

As of November 9th, 2020 Highway 337 from Medina to Vanderpool is closed at the Mill Creek Road. Any traffic coming to camp WILL NOT be able to use Highway 337 from Medina to get to camp. This is expected to last through March 2021.

PLEASE NOTE, Apple Maps and Google Maps are showing that there is only construction on Highway 337. It is not showing the road is closed. However, you are NOT ABLE to get to camp from Medina using Highway 337.

Below are some alternative routes you can use to get to camp. If you are using a different route than the one suggested below, please be aware you cannot get to camp through Medina using Highway 337.
