



2022 IAC Corporate Partner Guidelines

- Support the mission of IAC to promote county interests, encourage ethical behavior, advocate good public policy on behalf of Idaho's counties, supports best practices, and provides education and training to assist Idaho county officials in performance of public service.
- Address the professional needs of our members and Idaho's counties.
- Protect and maintain IAC's public trust, integrity, ethical standards, credibility, and identity.
- Not actively participate in or advocate for or against a specific policy position, political campaign, or political referendum or initiative at IAC events or use IAC communication materials, publications, or email lists for the furtherance of a prohibited activity.
- Be respectful and cautious when sending out emails and mailings to IAC members. Member contact information may not be harvested, sold to others, incorporated into any type of database, or used to generate mailing lists.

Companies or organizations that do not meet the above guidelines will be refused. Current IAC Corporate Partners that do not comply with the guidelines for Associate Membership will be canceled and refunded their yearly dues (prorated depending on the benefits that have been used to date).
