


MEMBERSHIP IN DECLINE

We are down 24% over the past 5 years. We have 22,000 less Vincentians today than we did in 2019. Not a single region grew membership in this period of time.

- 1. Launch "Just Ask" Program
 - → Referrals are the #1 "lead source" for Vincentians
 - → If every Vincentian asks just 1 person to join
 - → Make it fun
- 2. Not just a youth movement
 - \rightarrow YCP
 - → More than home visits
 - → Never write off the elderly

LEADERSHIP DEVELOPMENT

Goal: Create a culture of mentorship throughout the society

- 1. One day annual retreats
 - → Spiritual retreat
 - → Identifying & nurturing leaders




THE MOST EFFECTIVE WAY TO GROW CONFERENCE MEMBERS

"JUST ASK"

What is the "Just Ask" Campaign?

→ It is the program to bring 10,000 new members into the society by Sept. 30, 2026.

How does it work?

→ We want every Vincentian to "Just Ask" one person to join the Society this year.

Many of our older Vincentians are aging out of home visits.

Does that mean done being active Vincentians? ABSOLUTELY NOT!

Does that mean we stop doing home visits? ABSOLUTELY NOT!

Many opportunities are available for them to participate:

Conference Officer positions | Call back person | Assist with Annual Reports Maintain Conference records | Participate in Conference or Council events Mentor new members on Home Visits | Caller at Bingo night Volunteer in the Food Pantry | Make quilts for our FINs, Put together toiletry kits | Write thank you notes | Pray for us!

The list goes on!

BEFORE YOU EXPECT OTHERS TO JOIN YOU NEED TO ASK YOURSELF WHY DID YOU JOIN?

The 3 basic tenets of being a Vincentian are:

- 1. Spirituality
- 2. Friendship
- 3. Service to the Poor



MOST ANSWER

"I JOINED TO HELP THOSE LIVING IN POVERTY"













MOST STAY

- Spiritual enrichment of seeing and being the face of Christ
- 2. Friendships developed with other Vincentians & Neighbors
- 3. Serving our friends and neighbors who live in poverty



OK, you ask someone to consider joining SVDP. What now?

You did an Invitation To Serve at Church and have a follow up meeting. What's next?

Create a Culture of Welcome in your Conference!

- → Use the National Council Template: Creating a Culture of Welcome
- → Be flexible on meeting times and activities. (pizza parties, work shifts together at food pantries, stores, shelters, family dinners together.....etc.) Be creative!
- → Tell them they will see the Face of Christ in the Poor.
- → Tell them about life changing home visits. Transformative! For both the Vincentian and our Friend in Need. Use personal examples.

Always remember the 3 tenets of SVDP: Spirituality, Friendship and Service to the Poor!!!



SPIRITUALITY

ON THE CONFERENCE LEVEL:

- 1. GO TO MASS TOGETHER. ESPECIALLY ON VINCENTIAN FEAST DAYS
- 2. GOSPEL REFLECTION AT MEETINGS
- 3. USE THOUGHT PROVOKING PRAYERS FOR OPENING AND CLOSING MEETINGS
- 4. USE MUSIC
- 5. PASS THE CRUCIFIX! VERY POWERFUL

ON THE DISTRICT LEVEL:

- 1. SPIRITUAL RETREATS WITH BIG NAME SPEAKERS
- 2. MASS AT DISTRICT COUNCIL MEETINGS
- 3. ALWAYS BEGIN WITH A SPIRITUAL REFLECTION

BE CREATIVE AND BE BRAVE....JUST ASK!


