From Hartsfield-Jackson Airport, take MARTA north to Midtown Station (\$3, ~21 mins). Board the free Tech Trolley to the Georgia Tech Hotel & Conference Center. Driving distance is approximately 11 miles, or about 15–20 minutes depending on traffic.
