Field Trip Terms & Conditions:

- If you are sick or feel unwell, you must stay home. If you are unable to attend the trip for whatever reason, please contact the Registrar via email at registrations@sbbg.org or call 805-682-4726, ext 102
- Field trips will have no more than 16 participants including the Instructors.
- Pre-registration is required. Participants may not bring any additional guests who were not accounted for in registration.
- Participants are discouraged from sharing equipment with guests outside their household.
- Participants are encouraged to maintain 6 feet of distance between themselves and others not in their household.
- When indoors, all participants over the age of 2 must wear a well-fitting mask that covers the nose and mouth at all times. If your mask does not fit properly and requires frequent adjustment you may be asked to leave the group. Participants may choose to wear masks when outdoors, but it is not required. Masks may be temporarily removed to eat and drink, but should be replaced directly afterwards.
- Participants are encouraged to observe social distancing protocols with all guests at the location of the field trip.
- Be aware the natural setting of the field trip location which can include uneven walking surfaces, steep terrain and low branches – please watch your step. You may encounter pests and wildlife while visiting this location; please remain aware of your surroundings and leave wildlife undisturbed.
- If we find that participants are not following these Terms & Conditions we may be forced to stop group activities.

The health and safety of our members, volunteers and staff are our first priorities. Mandates and recommendations from county, state, and federal public health offices may change our ability to follow our limited opening plan. Despite ongoing cleaning and sanitizing protocols, we cannot control all circumstances.

The Garden is open rain or shine. Red Flag Warning days may trigger mandatory closure to SBBG visitors and staff. Red Flag Warnings are called by fire officials of the County of Santa Barbara.

<u>Cancellation Policy</u>: If you must cancel registration, refunds are granted upon request up to five business days before the class begins, less a \$5.00 handling charge. If the Garden cancels a class for any reason, a refund for the amount of the class (less the optional processing fee) will be given to all registrants. Refunds may require four weeks for processing.

<u>Photography Policy:</u> Class participants may be photographed during a class or trip. These pictures may be used by the Santa Barbara Botanic Garden for marketing purposes related to its mission. Please notify staff if you expressly prohibit such uses.
