FAQs

Q: *What's included in the cost of the event?*

A: By registering for the event, you will receive tent space, parking, meals catered by a small business from Southern Pennsylvania, and dozens of on-site events activities.

Q: *I paid my deposit. How do I pay my balance?*

A: To pay your balance, you may mail a check or submit a Venmo (see below). If you wish to pay on your original payment card, you don't need to do anything. Your card will be charged automatically on December 31, 2025.

Q: *Which meals will be provided?*

A: Meals for the event include a hot breakfast, full lunch, and hot dinner, Monday - Friday. Sunday meals not included

Q: *Will there be hot showers available at the location?*

A: Yes. Hot showers will be available for all attendees at the location.

Q: *What activities will be available on-site?*

A: On-site activities will be based in the 1776 period, and could include: games, lock-picking, battlefield tactics, flag-making, blacksmith, candle-making, rope-making, shelter-building, and cooking.

Q: *Will there be any shooting sports at the event?*

A: Yes, Events could include: archery, axe-throwing, archery tag and black powder muskets.

Q: *What will be taking place in the evening, after dinner?*

A: After dinner you will have the opportunity to listen to Trail Life guest speakers, worship together, and fellowship with other Trailmen.

Q: *What's additional activities will be available off-site?*

A: For an additional fee, you will have the opportunity to cross the Delaware in a canoe, hike Valley Forge, and go to historic downtown Philadelphia to see Independence Hall, the Liberty Bell and other locations that were crucial in the founding of America.

Q: *What is the fee for the off-site activities?*

A: The cost of the off-site activities will vary by outing. We expect a cost between \$20-\$40 per person per activity. Fees will include transportation and any associated fees for the activity.

Q: *If I want to join the activity to cross the Delaware, do I need a current swim test?*

A: Yes, all attendees who want to cross the Delaware will need to have earned the Aquatics badge after July 15, 2025 or have had a swim test after July 15, 2025 (*more information can be found in the Health & Safety Guide*).

A: Unfortunately, no. Swim tests must be completed prior to arrival.

Q: *What time should I arrive to check-in for the event?*

A: Check-in will be available between 12:30 - 5:00 p.m. on Sunday.

Q: *When will the event officially kick off?*

A: The event will formally begin at 7:00 p.m. on Sunday evening. All attendees must be checked in and set up by that time.
