Course 1: Cyber Intelligence Tradecraft Certification

This class is for anyone wishing to learn about cyber intelligence concepts and methods using open source tools for operational security, infiltration, analysis, recommendations and opportunities presentations, that provide their organizations with immediate understanding of their Internet attack surface. Students wishing to understand adversarial methods and concepts surrounding the virtual manifestation of the traditional intelligence tradecraft are urged to attend.

Course 2: Cyber Counterintelligence Tradecraft Certification

This course presents the student with foundational concepts and processes in the discipline of cyber counterintelligence with a focus on cyber counterintelligence missions, defensive counterintelligence, offensive counterintelligence, and counterespionage as these realms apply to traditional tradecraft, and how they are or will evolve into the cyber domain. By starting with traditional counterintelligence and progressing to cyber counterintelligence, the student will develop an appreciation for collection efforts, exploitation of potential threats, insider concerns, and the risks and benefits of counterintelligence.

Course 3: Clandestine Cyber HUMINT / OSINT Certification

The Clandestine Cyber HUMINT / OSINT course is designed to provide the student with tactics, techniques and methods for remaining anonymous while performing targeted adversary data collection.

Course 4: Clandestine Cyber Intelligence Analyst Certification

The Cyber Intelligence Analyst course educates students on the processes in the production of intelligence in which intelligence information is subjected to systematic examination in order to identify significant facts and derive conclusions. The course also focuses on the determination of the significance of the information relative to information and intelligence already known, and drawing deductions about the probable meaning of the evaluated information.

Cyber Intelligence Tradecraft Certification

COURSE DESCRIPTION

This course provides definitive sections along the intelligence lifecycle that are in-depth, aligned to DoD instructions such as the Joint Publication 2.0, DoDI 3305.13, and 3305.02. Following the intelligence lifecycle, students are required to demonstrate understanding and use of collection methods using defined targets and target case studies, understanding and applying analytic techniques, when and how to use analytic techniques and analytic types. Using direction from Sherman Kent and analytic methods from Richards Heuer, students are presented case studies for analysis, required to use tradecraft methods, and provide written reports in standard analytic format. Students are also required to orally present their deliverables to the class. Students leave this course with the tools, methods, and understanding necessary to enhance intelligence programs.

The course is taught in a crawl, walk, run format. What does that mean? We teach the academics first in classrooms style. We then follow up with a review of the materials in conjunction with case studies and scenarios. The run section of the course follows with case studies taking the student through the cyber intelligence lifecycle from priority intelligence and information requirements, task assignments, potential data sources and focus of analysis, potentially relevant data, examination of tactics, techniques, and procedures (TTPs), TTP use for hunt and detect, reductionism, usable data, structured methods of analysis, credibility and relevance of data findings, campaign analysis, analysis, analysis, review, poor review, written briefs and of data, findings, campaign analysis, analytic review, peer review, written briefs and assessments, and dissemination.

All students receive an Amazon Fire 7" **Tablet Display** WiFi 8GB Books are pushed to the tablet for classroom use. Students who complete the course will be certified as Cyber Intelligence Tradecraft Professional. CEU's Available at Student Request.

The follow-on to Cyber Intelligence Tradecraft Certification, this course educates students on a counterintelligence capability that is integrated with all aspects of the intelligence process that supports security operations, incident response, organizational resiliency, and competitive intelligence. Learn methods of denial and deception, social engineering, counterdenial and counter deception, target characteristics, perception and perception management as well as a guide to unusual online tactics.

What is cyber counterintelligence? Information gathered and activities conducted to identify, deceive, exploit, disrupt, or protect against cyber espionage, other online intelligence activities, or cyber sabotage, conducted for or on behalf of foreign powers, organizations or persons, or their agents, or international terrorist organizations or activities.

Students who complete the course will be certified as Cyber Counterintelligence **Tradecraft** Professional.

Clandestine Cyber HUMINT / OSINT

COURSE DESCRIPTION

Maintain your true identity and intelligence sources and methods, and your clandestine tactics, techniques, and procedures from exposure to adversaries and overt association with organizationally, sensitive activities. This course covers Tails installation and use, use of Tor and Dark Net searches, methods of anonymity, I2P installation and use, as well as the use of anonymous browsers and privacy related add-ons. Communicate covertly while establishing identities used in cyberspace to obtain information and influence others. Plan, implement, and manage your cyber persona(s).

The course aligns to DoDI 5240.23.

Students are provided 2 USB drives and a 1 year subscription to a VPN service.

COURSE DESCRIPTION

The Cyber Intelligence Analyst course educates students on the processes in the production of intelligence in which intelligence information is subjected to systematic examination in order to identify significant facts and derive conclusions. The course also focuses on the determination of the significance of the information relative to information and intelligence already known, and drawing deductions about the probable meaning of the evaluated information.

The course guides students through the conversion of processed information into intelligence through the integration, evaluation, analysis, and interpretation of all source data and the preparation of intelligence products in support of known or anticipated user requirements. Students will learn how to integrate, evaluate, and interpret information from available sources and develop intelligence products that enable situational awareness. Attendees practice and develop skills in applying learned techniques and methodologies appropriate to an issue to mitigate, gain insight, and provide persuasive understanding of the issue to stakeholders and organizational leadership.

This course follows the International Association for Intelligence Education Standards for Intelligence Analyst Initial Training.
