

Lankas Camp Rules

- Please cause no harm to the camp, its property or its wildlife.
- Fires should be built only with adult supervision in designated areas and times. Observe applicable burn bans.
- The camp is clean when you arrive please leave it in the same state when you leave. Please put all trash and recycling in appropriate receptacles.
- There will be no access to the lake, without explicit permission from, and in the presence of camp director.
- No camper shall leave the camp without explicit permission from the camp director and their designated counselor.
- Swimming in the swimming pool is permitted only when a lifeguard is in attendance & pool is officially open.
- Vehicles must be parked in the assigned area near the entrance of the camp other than when loading or unloading from the kitchen or dormitories.
- Washington State Laws also apply at the camp (underage drinking is not allowed).

Code of Conduct

- I will respect my fellow campers, counselors, parents, and their property.
- Lankas Camp is a Lithuanian heritage camp, not a Lithuanian language camp. I will welcome and treat all fellow campers equally regardless of their Lithuanian or English language skills.
- I agree to participate with a positive attitude at camp and obey camp counselors and all stated rules.
- I will stay with my group during scheduled activities. It is my responsibility to make sure that my counselor knows where I am at all times.
- I will not cause physical or emotional harm to other campers, including bullying, excluding others, harassment, aggressive behavior, or harmful pranks.
- I agree not to bring any illegal substances, alcohol, tobacco, or weapons to camp. Any use or possession of illegal substances, underage drinking, smoking, or sexual behavior is strictly prohibited and is grounds for immediate expulsion from camp.
- My parents are responsible for being aware of the items I bring to camp. If I bring an item to camp, it is my responsibility including any damages or breakages that occur. Keep this in mind when bringing any valuable or expensive items to camp. Any item that disturbs other campers, creates distraction, or otherwise disturbs the camp program will be removed from the camper's possession until the end of camp.
- If I break any of these rules, I can be expelled from camp, and my parents will arrange for my immediate transport home. My parents agree to be reachable by their emergency number for my entire stay at camp.

Camp counselors will deal with disciplinary problems or refer them to leadership as needed. The head counselor and directors have the authority to exclude a camper from camp activities, call parents, or expel people from camp at their discretion.

Parents/guardians are required to be onsite upon the conclusion of camp- by 7pm on Friday and are responsible for their minor children from that point on. We invite everyone to join us for Friday evening activities structured for youth and adults. I understand the Lankas Camp Rules and the Code of Conduct, and promise to respect them. I understand that I will be sent home for inappropriate behavior, such as smoking, drinking alcohol, using illegal drugs, or bullying.
