



PIKE University Educational Assessments Reinstated

After a three-year hiatus, PIKE University will reinstate our historical practice of educational assessments on September 1, 2023. As mentioned in previous correspondence, undergraduate delegates at the 2018 International Convention in Richmond, Virginia unanimously amended the Fraternity Standards by adding an expectation of minimum attendance levels for every type of PIKE U event. The minimum attendance level set for a Leadership Summit is five (5) attendees, the Chapter Executives Conference is three (3) attendees, and the Leadership Academy is three (3) attendees. Any chapter that fails to meet the minimum attendance requirement will be issued an educational assessment. Educational assessments are not a fine. The amount will be kept in your chapter's PIKE U scholarship account to be applied toward registration at a future PIKE U event.

To further encourage participation at PIKE U events, the Fraternity is awarding every chapter \$1,000 to their PIKE U scholarship fund that meets the minimum attendance requirements at each event at the end of the academic year. These funds will be available on July 1 to help relieve the cost of registration fees for attendance at future events.



- **Minimum Attendance Requirement:** 5 per chapter
- **Educational Assessment for No Representation:** *Registration fee times 5 attendees + one-night hotel stay at the PIKE discounted rate*
- **Educational Assessment for under 5 attendees:** *Registration fee times the number short of 5 attendees*
- **Educational Assessments for Leadership Summits will be issued in March of each year.**



- **Minimum Attendance Requirement:** 3 per chapter
- **Educational Assessment for No Representation:** *Registration fee times 3 attendees + two-night hotel stay at the PIKE discounted rate*
- **Educational Assessment for under 3 attendees:** *Registration fee times the number short of 3 attendees*
- **Educational Assessments for Leadership Summits will be issued in January of each year.**
