

Maysville Fall Youth Retreat 2019 - CAMPER CODE OF CONDUCT FORM

1. All campers are to attend all services, sessions, activities, meals, and other events that are part of the camp.
2. Boys are not to go into the girls' dorm and girls are not to go into the boys' dorm. All campers are to with the larger group at all times. No two campers are to be in rooms or isolated area except in their assigned lodging rooms at bedtime.
3. Keep your room, the buildings and grounds, and the restrooms neat and clean.
4. Remain within the boundaries of the campgrounds at all times.
5. At the time of "Lights Out," be in your assigned lodging room and quiet.
6. Dress modestly. Wear clothing that covers you properly and is not revealing. Refrain from clothing that has suggestive words, pictures, or offensive advertising.
7. Do not destroy or damage the property of the camp, cabin owners or other campers.
8. Cell phones and all electronic devices are to be turned off and put away during all services, activities, and after 'lights out' time at night. Consult with the Camp Director, your team leader or counselor BEFORE making any phone calls, including calls home. If someone phones you, including your family, advise them you are not to be on the phone. If there is an emergency have your parents contact the camp director at 859-421-6869.
9. No smoking, vaping, ecigarettes, tobacco or alcohol use, foul language, pornography, or anything that would not be pleasing to God and appropriate for a church youth camp environment.
10. The Dining Hall is our eating area as well as our place of worship. During service times it becomes our sanctuary of worship, therefore do not bring food or drinks with you to the services. In addition, if you must move your chair during the service times, please do so in a way that will not make noise.
11. Campers are expected to adhere to the Code of Conduct themselves, AND are expected to report violations they observe in other campers. Campers who are aware of a willful violation of the Camper Code of Conduct and who do not report it will be subject to disciplinary action along with the offender.
12. In all Camp Dorms, Rooms, & Retreat Center, only 1 person is to be assigned per bed. Bed sharing of any kind between campers is unacceptable.
13. Show respect at all times to fellow campers and camp staff. Disrespect for authority, any sort of bullying or unkind behavior will not be tolerated.
14. Use common sense. You pretty well know if something is right or wrong even if it is not listed here. Do the right thing and things will go better for all of us.

Consequences may include the following:

1. The situation addressed by one of the camp staff
2. The situation addressed by the Camp Director as well as possibly a team of several others
3. Loss of privileges, such as having to sit out of certain activities or limitation of freedoms
4. Contact parents or guardians about the misconduct
5. Camper is sent home. If this is the case it is the responsibility of the parents or guardians to make immediate arrangements to pick up the camper at the campgrounds at their expense.

NOTE: The camp, camp personnel, other campers, and The Wesleyan Church are not responsible for items that are damaged, lost or stolen. There is no secure place to keep valuables at the camp. Please leave them at home or send them back home with your driver. This includes cell phones and electronic devices, money in excess of what is needed for the Snack Shack, jewelry, expensive clothing, etc.

All medications, including prescriptions and over-the-counter drugs, are to be lodged with the Camp Nurse upon registration. She will ensure proper administration at appropriate times.
