
Minutemen Youth Wrestling Present:

A wrestler can move up <u>one</u> age group with the permission of the tournament director, provided this request is made before bracketing is completed. A wrestler can only compete in one bracket for each session. The only division that can wrestle in both sessions is the Intermediate division, because the

wrestler can wrestle in the morning session as an Intermediate and move up one division to Novice for the afternoon session.

The coach requesting the division change must show their current Wrestling Leader card.

Therefore, this request cannot be made by anyone without a Wrestling Leader's card.

Brackets for Female Matches will be made available as wrestler availability and registration allow. Novice/Middle School Female only brackets will be in the am while Mighty Mite/Bantam/Intermediate will be held in the pm. Female wrestlers may wrestle in both co-ed and female only brackets at no additional registration fee. Please contact us at Info@minutemenyouthwrestling.com

TECH FALLS will occur when a 12 point margin is achieved, this rule applies to all age groups

Notice:

- □ Each Club's director or designated person for that club will check in with the Tournament Director, inform the Director of any known NO SHOW wrestlers and pay for their team's entry. Note: There are *no refunds for no-shows* each club is responsible for full payment.
- All wrestlers must check in by the end of the Skin check-in time period to verify they do not have any contagious skin conditions. Wrestlers will not be admitted into the tournament if they are not checked in on time.
- □ It is the responsibility of the Club Directors, or the designated person for that club, to check with the head person running the Skin check in area to see if any of their wrestlers have not checked in by 8:15am for the morning session and 11:45am for the afternoon session.
- □ Each wrestler's weight must adequately represent the weight that they will be come tournament morning. <u>Every</u> wrestler will be required to check-in the morning of the tournament to be weighed and get a skin check.
 - All Wrestlers will report for skin check and be weighed in before Tournament starts. Weights
 reported by Coaches will be corrected, however any wrestler over 3 pounds over what the Coach
 has registered them for will be disqualified from Tournament. This Rule applies to all
 Tournaments.
 - When weighing-in, each wrestler must weigh-in wearing a competition singlet
 - Weight Classes: A Madison weight class system will be followed. All wrestlers will be grouped relative to both their age and weight. There are no published and strict weight classes to follow during the regular season. The maximum weight distribution will be no more than 10%, without coaches' approval.

Head gear will be required for all age groups this is a USA Wrestling rule.

ALL WRESTLERS WITH BRACES ON THEIR TEETH MUST HAVE PROTECTIVE MOUTH GUARDS

Registration-

- ✓ All tournaments require pre-registration. Absolutely <u>NO Walk-ins</u>
- ✓ Only Directors, or their appointee, of sanctioned clubs will be allowed to pre-register wrestlers. Wrestlers who are not club affiliated or are from out-of-state are requested to contact the Tournament Director directly by the Thursday immediately before the event.
- ✓ All wrestlers are required to have a current USA Wrestling membership.
- ✓ Wrestlers in need of a card should contact their club director or purchase them on www.usawmembership.com. Arrangements must be made by each Wednesday prior to a Sunday Tournament to allow proper issuance of cards, NO EXCEPTIONS
- ✓ Tournament registration fees are \$20 for each individual, \$14 for 2nd, \$8 for any additional family members.
