2024 Camping Guidelines and Information

- A non-refundable 50% deposit of the total reservation fee is required within 10 days of your reservation to hold your desired facilities and/or usage. Please initial here stating you understand that if you must cancel your stay, your deposit will not be refunded to you. Initials: _____
- The camp has primitive, non-electric campsites. Bedding is not provided in the cabins.
- Guests must respect the rights of others, including the neighborhood private property owners. This includes staying off private property not owned by Black Hills Camp.
- No excessive noise. Violation will result in immediate removal from camp (Quiet hours 10 PM – 7 AM), no refunds will be given.
- **No Alcohol, illegal drugs or personal weapons allowed on camp property. Violation will result in immediate removal, no refunds will be given.**
- Smoking is not permitted in any enclosed facility. Please discard cigarette butts in provided containers around camp.
- Fires are permitted in the grilling area of the Outdoor Pavilion and the Council Ring US Forest Service fire restrictions will be observed when posted which could include no campfires in the Council Ring. Violation of US Forest Service fire restrictions will result in immediate removal, no refunds will be given.
- All pets **MUST** be on a leash, **MUST** be cleaned up after, and may **NOT** be left unattended at any time. **PETS ARE NOT ALLOWED IN ANY ENCLOSED FACILITY.**
- Proper Clean-Up of all facilities used (leaving it as you found it) is expected before departing camp.
- All perishable and non-perishable food must be removed from kitchen and/or lodge when leaving camp.
- All trash and refuse must be put in garbage bags and placed in the dumpster at the entrance of camp.
- Occupants must sign Hold Harmless Agreement below.

HOLD HARMLESS AGREEMENT

I the undersigned, _____, have read and understand the Fee Schedule and Camping Guidelines for use of The Black Hills Salvation Army Camp, and agree to indemnify and hold The Salvation Army, officials, agents, employees and volunteers harmless against any and all claims, demands, damages, costs, and expenses, including reasonable attorneys' fees for the defense of such claims and demands, arising from the conduct, management, or operation of The Salvation Army property by the undersigned, or from any breach on the part of the undersigned of any conditions of this agreement, or from any act or negligence of the undersigned, its agents or employees, in or about the premises.

Furthermore, by signing this occupancy agreement, I release The Salvation Army, its officials, agents, employees and volunteers from any claim that I may have or that the other participants may have against them as a result of injury, illness or death incurred during the course of participation in the activities.

In occupying the facility, The Salvation Army does not relinquish the right to control the management thereof, and to enforce all necessary and property rules for management and operation of the same, and The Salvation Army through its director, officers and other designated representatives, shall have the right at any time to enter any portion of said premises for any purpose whatsoever.

The Salvation Army reserves the right to revoke this agreement as it sees fit. The Salvation Army also reserves the right to close the premises at any given time for any purpose.
